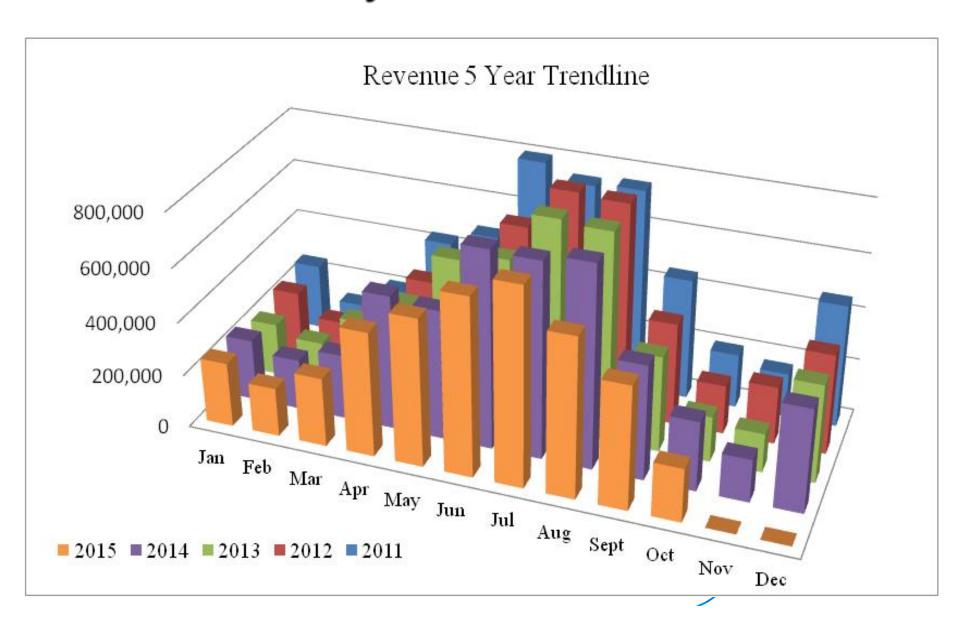

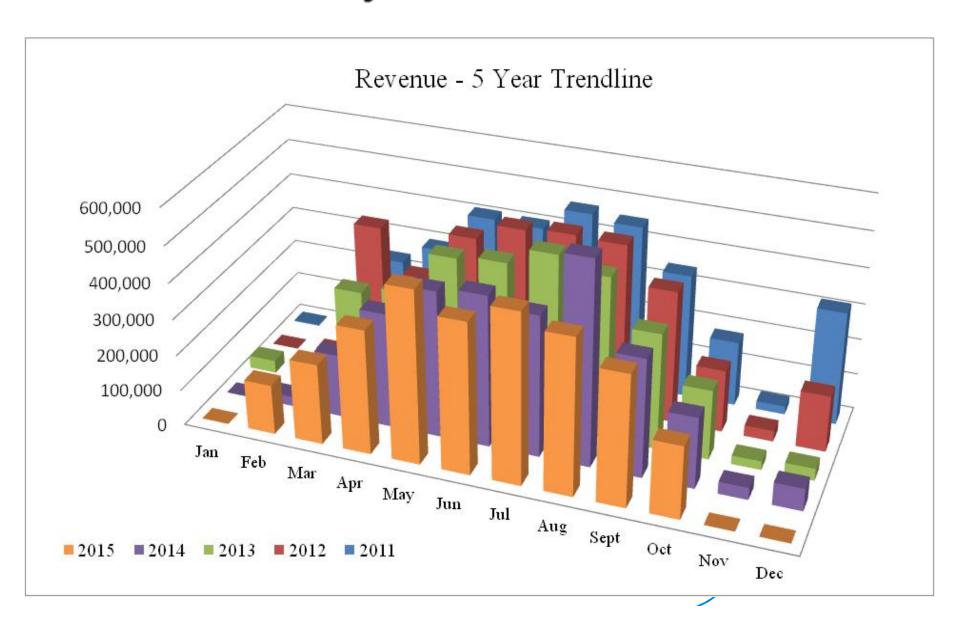
Revenue by Month – Park Fund
