Background/history: Through an application process Spokane Youth and Senior Association Community Centers requested one-time additional investments to improve facility assets that offer long term benefits to the community, enhance accessibility, increase recreation services to the undeserved and project that demonstrate collaboration with other community funding sources. Four (4) applications were received, these application were reviewed and evaluated by the Recreation Committee of Park Board. Two (2) of the Four (4) applications were awarded their full requested amount, and the two (2) other centers were awarded \$1,500 each to go towards their requested projects. - Northeast Youth Center for the amount of \$3,000 to support the purchase cost of new kitchen equipment. - Project Joy for the amount of \$4,000 to support the purchase and installation of an accessible chair lift. - Hillyard Senior Center and Southside Community Center to each receive \$1,500 to support their technology upgrade needs. These are one-time funding dollars are to be paid upon receipt of a detailed invoice of completion. Total funding support amount for 2024 is \$10,000 from a designated Capital Fund in the Parks Fund for Community Centers.
