Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by committee chair Gerry Sperling.

Public comment: None

Action Items:

- A. 2024 Riverfront Spokane fees and charges *Jonathan Moog* presented. There are no proposed changes for Attractions rates. The proposed changes are to bring event and rental prices in line with comparable venues in the region.
 - Motion #1 Gerry Sperling moved to recommend the 2024 Riverfront Spokane fees and charges

Kevin Brownlee seconded.

The motion passed with unanimous consent (3-0 vote). It is proposed to place this as a regular action item on the agenda for the October 12 Park Board meeting.

Information Items:

- A. Park Ranger 24-hour Service *Jacob Vandenberg* presented. Interim Park Ranger Supervisor Vandenberg shared the successes and some statistics of the program operating 24 hours a day through the summer.
- B. Zipline update *Jonathan Moog* presented. Jon shared that the committee had approved the one bidder on the project to move forward with an initial contract, which is in process.

Standing Report Items:

A. September 2023 Operations Report – Jonathan Moog presented. Highlights included: 1) Discounted Unlimited Ice Passes are for sale through November 17th; 2) an annual pass encompassing all attractions year round is in the works and hopes to launch before the holidays; 3) Pig Out in the Park brought Riverfront into September; 4) the Modest Mouse/Pixies concert was the largest of the concert season in both attendance and sales, and utilized the technology to sync the light blades with the performance; 5) the Submission Challenge Brazilian Jiu Jitsu Tournament was held in the Pavilion amphitheater with the closing matches being a ticketed event under the Pavilion lights (this event showcased the flexibility of the Pavilion for different types of use); and 6) Fall Fest closed out the month in partnership with River Park Square and the DSP, having a larger footprint downtown.

Adjournment: The meeting was adjourned at 5:33 p.m.
