*Projects highlighted in **RED** have notable changes this week. Construction is tentative and subject to change at any time.*

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

29TH AVENUE GRIND & OVERLAY

- 29th Avenue between Ray Street and Grand Boulevard is reduced to one lane in each direction.

This work is two separate projects, [Market/Monroe/29th Grind & Overlay](#) and [29th/Washington/Monroe/Lincoln Grind & Overlay](#) that will grind and overlay pavement and install ADA ramps.

COCHRAN CONTROL FACILITY

- Work continues with no traffic impacts.

This project will construct a stormwater flow control vault.

This is a \$7.3 million project.

CYCLE 10 TRAFFIC CALMING

- Crews are working at the following locations.
 - Boone Avenue and Stone Street
 - Boone Avenue and Cook Street
 - **Marietta Avenue, Perry to Madelia Street**
 - **Marietta Avenue and Perry Street**
 - **Jackson Avenue and Perry Street**

This project aims to enhance the overall infrastructure, ensuring better pedestrian safety, traffic flow, and drainage in the area.

This is a \$3 million project.

DIVISION STREET PEDESTRIAN HYBRID BEACONS

- Division Street has lane closures in each direction between Crown and Cozza Avenue.

This project aims to enhance pedestrian safety and accessibility by installing crossing signals at three uncontrolled crosswalks on Division Street. These locations include Division/Longfellow, Division/Everett, and Division/Rhodes-Weile.

This is a \$1.2 million project.

HAVEN GRIND & OVERLAY

- Haven Street is reduced to one lane between Columbia and Rockwell Avenue.

This project will grind and overlay pavement and install ADA ramps as needed.

This is a \$1 million project.

HIGH SYSTEM WATER TANK

- No impacts to the traveling public are anticipated.

This project will construct a 2-million-gallon elevated steel and concrete water reservoir on the Hamblen Elementary property just south of Hamblen Park.

This is a \$9.8 million project.

MAPLE/ASH CHIP SEAL

- Maple and Ash Street has rotating single-lane closures between Rowan Avenue and Northwest Boulevard.

This project will chip seal on the Maple/Ash corridor from Northwest Boulevard to Rowan Avenue.

This is a \$1.8 million project.

MARSHALL ROAD & CHENEY SPOKANE ROAD WATER TRANSMISSION MAIN

- Thorpe Road between U.S. 195 and the railroad tunnel is **scheduled to reopen on Monday, May 13.**
- Cheney-Spokane Road between the Hwy 195 interchange and Latah Bistro is reduced to one lane in each direction.
- Marshall Road south of Thorpe Road is closed; residents are recommended to go south to Spokane Cheney Road for access.

The Marshall Road Water Transmission work is composed of three projects. These projects are underway to enhance water and sewer infrastructure in the Cheney-Spokane Road and Marshall Road area, aiming to improve water transmission capacity and provide service to local parcels.

This is a \$9.9 million project.

MONROE STREET GRIND & OVERLAY

- Monroe Street between Kiernan and Francis Avenue is reduced to one lane in each direction.
- **There will be flaggers at the intersection of Garland Avenue and Monroe Street.**

This work is two separate projects, [Market/Monroe/29th Grind & Overlay](#) and [29th/Washington/Monroe/Lincoln Grind & Overlay](#) that will grind and overlay pavement and install ADA ramps.

POST STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

- The Post Street Bridge is closed. [See the detour routes for pedestrians and bicyclists.](#)
- **Post Street angled parking is closed in front of City Hall.**
- The intersection of Lincoln Street and Summit Boulevard is closed.
- Post Street is closed at Spokane Falls Boulevard with local access only. Parking is limited on Post, and the Riverfront Park parking lot on Post just south of the bridge is closed.

This project will replace the Post Street Bridge and associated utilities.

This is an \$18.5 million project.

RAY STREET WATER MAIN

- The following streets will be closed.
 - Hartson Avenue between Ralph and Greene Street.
 - Ray Street between Harston and 11th Avenue.

This project will replace an aging water main along Ray Street, stretching from Hartson Avenue to 11th Avenue.

This is a \$1.4 million project.

SOUTH GORGE TRAIL CONNECTION

- No impacts to the traveling public are anticipated.

This project constructs a shared-use pathway under the Monroe Street Bridge connecting Main Avenue west of Monroe Street to the existing path attached to the north side of Spokane Falls Boulevard across from the Central Library.

This is a \$2 million project.

SPOKANE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT RESERVOIR

- No impacts to the traveling public are anticipated.
- Construction will be complete in 2024.

This project will construct a 3.6-million-gallon drinking water reservoir near the Spokane International Airport.

This is a \$13.3 million project funded with state and local funds.

STREET MAINTENANCE CURB RAMPS (2024)

- Crews are installing curb ramps at the following locations.
 - Garland Avenue and Lindeke Street
 - Garland Avenue and Milton Street
 - Garland Avenue and A Street
 - Garland Avenue and Audubon Street
 - Garland Avenue and C Street
 - Garland Avenue and D Street
 - Chelan Avenue and Madison Street
 - Mallon Avenue and Madelia Street
 - Wellesley Avenue and Crestline Street island

This project will install ADA ramps on streets which will receive a grind and overlay by the Street Department.

This is a \$500,000 project.

STREET MAINTENANCE CURB RAMPS (2023)

- Work on this project starts Monday, May 13. Crews will be installing curb ramps at the following locations.
 - Inland Empire Way and 23rd Avenue
 - Inland Empire Way and 21st Avenue
 - Inland Empire Way and 40' South of the bridge
 - Riverside Avenue and Hemlock Street

This project will install ADA ramps on streets which will receive a grind and overlay by the Street Department.

This is a \$1.2 million project.

THOR-FREYA 2ND/3RD INTERSECTIONS

- The following streets are closed.
 - 2nd Avenue between Freya and Thor Street.
 - Westbound I-90 Exit 283B Thor/Freya off-ramp.

This project involves full roadway reconstruction with concrete, curb and stormwater facilities replacement, ADA ramp upgrades, and water/sewer replacements.

This is a \$4.4 million project.

THORPE RESERVOIR (THORPE & TRAINOR RD)

- Work continues with no traffic impacts.

This project construct five MG ground level steel water reservoir.

This is a \$5.1 million project.

WASHINGTON STREET GRIND & OVERLAY

- Crews are working at the following locations.
 - Washington Street is reduced to one lane in each direction between Maxwell Avenue and the Spokane River.
 - Boone Avenue is reduced to a single lane at Washington Street.

This project will grind and overlay pavement and install ADA ramps.

CITY OBSTRUCTIONS

- 29th Avenue will be reduced to one lane between Howard Street and High Drive Parkway from 4/29/24 to 5/10/24 for Avista Utilities work.
- The eastbound curb lane of Indiana Avenue will be closed between Calispel and Atlantic Street from 4/29/24 to 5/10/24 for Avista Utilities light pole replacement work.
- The west curb lane of Stevens Street will be closed between 6th Avenue to just south of 7th Avenue from 4/29/24 to 5/10/24 for North Sky Communications fiber work.
- The eastbound curb lane of Francis Avenue will be closed between Winston Drive and N Street from 3/11/24 to 5/10/24 for TDS Metrocom work.
- The northbound curb lane of Grand Boulevard will be closed between 14th and 9th Avenue from 4/8/24 to 5/10/24 for Avista Utilities pole replacement.
- Driscoll Boulevard between Longfellow Avenue and Bismark Place will have lane closures with flaggers on-site from 3/11/24 to 5/11/24 to support utility work by TDS Metrocom.
- TDS Metrocom will be working at the following locations from 3/26/24 to 5/12/24.
 - The southbound curb lane of Indian Trail Road will be closed between Francis and Elmhurst Avenue.
 - The eastbound curb lane of Francis Avenue will be closed between Fotheringham and A Street.
- The north curb lane of Second Avenue will be closed between Howard and Lincoln Street from 4/29/24 to 5/15/24 for Garco utility work.
- The eastbound curb lane of Holland Avenue between Dakota and Nevada Street from 4/15/24 to 5/15/24 for Mastec work.

- Mastec will be working in the following areas from 4/12/24 to 5/15/24 to support aerial utility installation.
 - Northbound and southbound Crestline Street lane closures with flaggers on-site between Columbia and Lyons Avenue.
 - The eastbound curb lane of Francis Avenue closed between Napa and Crestline Street.
 - The westbound curb lane of Francis Avenue closed between Stone and Crestline Street.
- The east curb lane of Lincoln Street will be closed between 2nd Avenue and Railroad Alley Avenue from 4/1/24 to 5/15/24 for Garco Construction work.
- TDS Metrocom will be working in the following areas from 4/17/24 to 5/16/24 for fiber work.
 - The center lane of Division Street is closed between Cozza Drive and Lincoln Road.
 - The westbound curb lane of Lincoln Road between Standard and Division Street.
- **Post Street will be closed between Riverside and 1st Avenue from 5/6/24 to 5/16/24 for Palouse Power LLC work.**
- TDS Telecom will be working in the following areas from 1/8/24 to 5/17/24 to support cable installation.
 - Southbound Standard Street shoulder closed between Gettysburg Drive and Weile Avenue.
 - Northbound Cozza Drive shoulder closed between Calkins Drive and Dakota Street.
 - Northbound Standard Street shoulder closed between Cozza Drive and Greta Avenue.
- Rowan Avenue between Driscoll Boulevard and Fleming Street will have lane closures with flaggers on-site from 3/18/24 to 5/17/24 for TDS Telecom work.
- The westbound curb lane of Mission Avenue will be closed between Normandie and Washington Street from 4/18/24 to 5/17/24 for Mastec work.
- Northwest Boulevard island between Cora Avenue and Audubon Street will be closed with flaggers on-site from 4/18/24 to 5/18/24 for Mastec work.
- The westbound shoulder of Electric Avenue will be closed between Thomas Mallen Road to Dowdy Road from 2/22/24 to 5/20/24 for Mastec work.
- Evergreen Excavating LLC will be working at the following locations from 2/26/24 to 5/26/24.
 - 3rd Avenue will have a two-lane closure between Madison and Wall Street.
 - Post Street will be closed between 2nd and 3rd Avenue.
- The south curb lane of Main Avenue will be closed between Division and Pine Street from 4/25/24 to 5/27/24 for Mastec to perform aerial fiber work.

- There will be intermittent flagging at the intersection of Driscoll Boulevard and Sanson Place from 5/1/24 to 5/31/24 for TDS Telecom fiber installation work.
 - Upriver Drive is closed at Fredrick Avenue from 4/8/24 to 5/31/24.
 - **Arthur Street is closed at 3rd Avenue north to the dead end from 4/29/24 to 5/31/24 for NPL Construction Co. work.**
 - The westbound curb lane of Illinois Avenue will be closed between Hogan and Perry Street from 4/29/24 to 5/31/23 for Devout Excavations work.
 - Flaggers will be at the intersection of Monroe Street and Euclid Avenue from 3/11/24 to 6/1/24 for Mastec work.
 - The two middle lanes of Division Street will be closed between Ermina and Augusta Avene from 5/3/24 to 6/3/24 for Mastec to perform aerial fiber work.
 - **The southbound curb lane of Alberta Street will be closed between Rowan and Everett Avenue from 5/6/24 to 6/5/24 for TDS Metrocom work.**
 - The eastbound curb lane of 4th Avenue will be closed between Washington and Bernard Street from 3/11/24 to 6/11/24 for Mastec work.
 - **The southbound curb lane of Southeast Boulevard will be closed between 13th and 14th Avenue from 5/16/24 to 6/17/24 for Mastec work.**
 - **16th Avenue between U.S. 195 and Nettleton Lane will be closed from 5/13/24 to 7/18/24 for Corridor Contractors LLC work.**
- The eastbound center lane of Francis Avenue will be closed between Market and Sycamore Street from 4/1/24 to 10/29/24.

SPECIAL EVENTS

- **Junior Lilac Parade** – Saturday, May 11, 6 a.m. – 1:30 p.m.
The following streets will be closed:
 - Washington/Stevens Street, Boone to Main Avenue
 - Spokane Falls Boulevard, Bernard to Post Street
 - Main Avenue, Howard to Washington Street

SPOKANE PARKS AND RECREATION

CORBIN PARK

- The park will receive a new sport court, with two dedicated pickleball courts and one tennis court. Demolition of the existing court happened over fall, with new surfacing and amenities opening in the spring.

COEUR D'ALENE PARK

- A new irrigation system is being installed February – fall 2024. The park will remain open for use, with rotating sectional closures.

STREET DEPARTMENT PROJECTS

CRACK SEALING

- Arterial Crack Sealing
 - Indiana Avenue, Monroe to Division Street
- Residential Crack Sealing
 - Augusta Avenue, Monroe to Howard Street et al

BRIDGE WORK

- Crews are cleaning various bridges throughout the City, there will be lane closures.

GRIND AND OVERLAY

- Crews are working on a grind and overlay project on Magnesium Road between Division and Nevada Street.

POTHOLE CREWS

- City crews continue to fill potholes as weather allows. If you see a pothole, report it by calling **3-1-1**. Potholes can also be reported online through [your MySpokane account](#). Crews focus on the largest holes on the busiest streets first. Include as much information as possible on the location and size of the pothole.

SWEEPING CREWS

- Northwest
 - Rt. 8, Kathleen – north City limits, Indian Trail Rd. – Skyline Dr.
- Northeast
 - Rt. 27, Wellesley – Upriver Dr., Havana – Crestline
- South
 - Rt. 41, Hartson – 23rd Ave., Freya – Havana

ADDITIONAL WORK

- Weather permitting, our concrete crew will be working on utility repairs throughout the city.

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT)

CHILDREN OF THE SUN TRAIL

- This project continues to expand on the current Children of the Sun Trail located along the North Spokane Corridor between Columbia and Carlisle Avenue.

[NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPOKANE RIVER CROSSING](#)

- South Riverton Avenue between Ermina Avenue and Fiske Street is closed.
- Upriver Drive is closed between Ralph Street to under the Greene Street Bridge until Friday, June 28, for in-water and bridge work as part of the North Spokane Corridor River Crossing project. A detour is provided via Freya, Euclid, Crestline and Perry Street.
- This project will construct the North Spokane Corridor bridge that will cross the Spokane River and connect the skyway portion near Spokane Community College to the south and at Carslie Avenue to the north of the river.

[NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/SPOKANE R. TO COLUMBIA – NEW SEGEMENT](#)

- The new section of the North Spokane Corridor from Freya to Wellesley Avenue opened in November 2023.
- **Euclid Avenue between Market and Ralph Street reopened to traffic on Wednesday, May 8, after the closure to repave the roadway. Minor work on the shoulders and off the roadway will remain ongoing around Euclid Avenue.**
