So, you are interested in becoming a vendor with the City of Spokane.

To help you get ready to work with City, we want you to be aware of some of the requirements of you as a potential vendor for the City. This checklist will give you a starting point in gathering the required documents that will be requested should you be selected as a vendor.

Minimum Requirements to engage in business with the City:

- ⇒ A City of Spokane endorsement on your Washington State Business License https://dor.wa.gov/
- ⇒ Business Name, Business Address, Primary Contact Person, Phone Number and Email

Will you be providing a service? If yes, there are few additional minimum requirement to prepare for:

- ⇒ Insurance minimums
 - Workers Compensation
 - General Liability/Umbrella for a minimum coverage aggregate of \$2,000,000
 - Automobile Liability for a minimum coverage of \$1,000,000

Additional insurances may apply depending on services being provided.

If your service will be a Public Works, requires Prevailing Wage, is a Professional or Architect/Engineering Service, then MRSC registration is a must.
