Public Comment Period:

- WSDOT will be updating the State Bicycle Plan in 2019. Opportunities will be available for review and input in the coming months.
- Requesting an update on the sidewalk/bike lane at Nine Mile Hill, which is state property and not managed by the City of Spokane. City Liaison's suggests inputting feedback during the planning phases in the coming months.
- Inquiring about the four parking spots at the corner of Lincoln at the bridge that break up the bicycle lane and suggests that they be removed to prevent the bicycle traffic from having to enter traffic.

Board Briefing Session:

3) Chair Report -

- a. CTAB is the Citizen's Transportation Advisory Board that helps decide what happens with the extra \$20 fee that is applied when you renew your vehicle registration to help pay for residential streets and sidewalk repairs. It consists of 1 member from each City Council District as well as a person at large and a person from the planning committee and the bicycle advisory board. Most of the projects are associated with the City's 6 year transportation plan.
- b. Plan Commission Transportation Subcommittee also has a liaison from the BAB. This board oversees the 2014 transportation levy funds to help set the priorities for the arterials for the 6 year transportation funds.

4) Staff Report -

- a. There is an advertisement for an active transportation planner position open in Olympia through Washington State Department of Transportation, this is open until June 27, 2019 if anyone is interested.
- b. The City of Spokane Planning Department was approved to open a planning position that will have the sole focus of mobility transportation planning and bicycle infrastructure.
