Public Comment:

Jeff Sevela commented that bike lanes aren't treated with the same legitimacy as car lanes, which is why they often aren't plowed or given adequate detours. He also mentioned that it should be made clear that the BAB meetings are open to the public.

Briefing Session:

Minutes from the November 16, 2021 meeting approved unanimously.

1. Liaison Report -

- Rhonda Young reported that Plan Commission Transportation Subcommittee met in December.
 Spokane Regional Transportation Council (SRTC) gave a presentation about the
 DivisionConnects project and City staff presented Roadways of Significance. The Roadways of Significance is a mechanism for projects to be funded that would not otherwise be funded.
- Grant Shipley reported that Citizen Transportation Advisory Board (CTAB) didn't meet in December.

2. Chair Report -

• Grant Shipley reported he has been riding on bike lanes, but the snow has become an impediment and made many lanes unusable.

3. Staff Report -

- Colin Quinn-Hurst reported that Mike Bjordahl's term at the BAB has ended and presented Mr. Bjordahl with a Certificate of Appreciation and a commemorative mug.
- Colin also presented the active bicycle project tracking sheet to the BAB and noted a new project, a pathway under Monroe Street Bridge near along Spokane Falls Blvd. is currently being designed.
- He also reported that there are 4 vacancies on the Bicycle Advisory Board. The BAB has received 9 applications to fill them.




