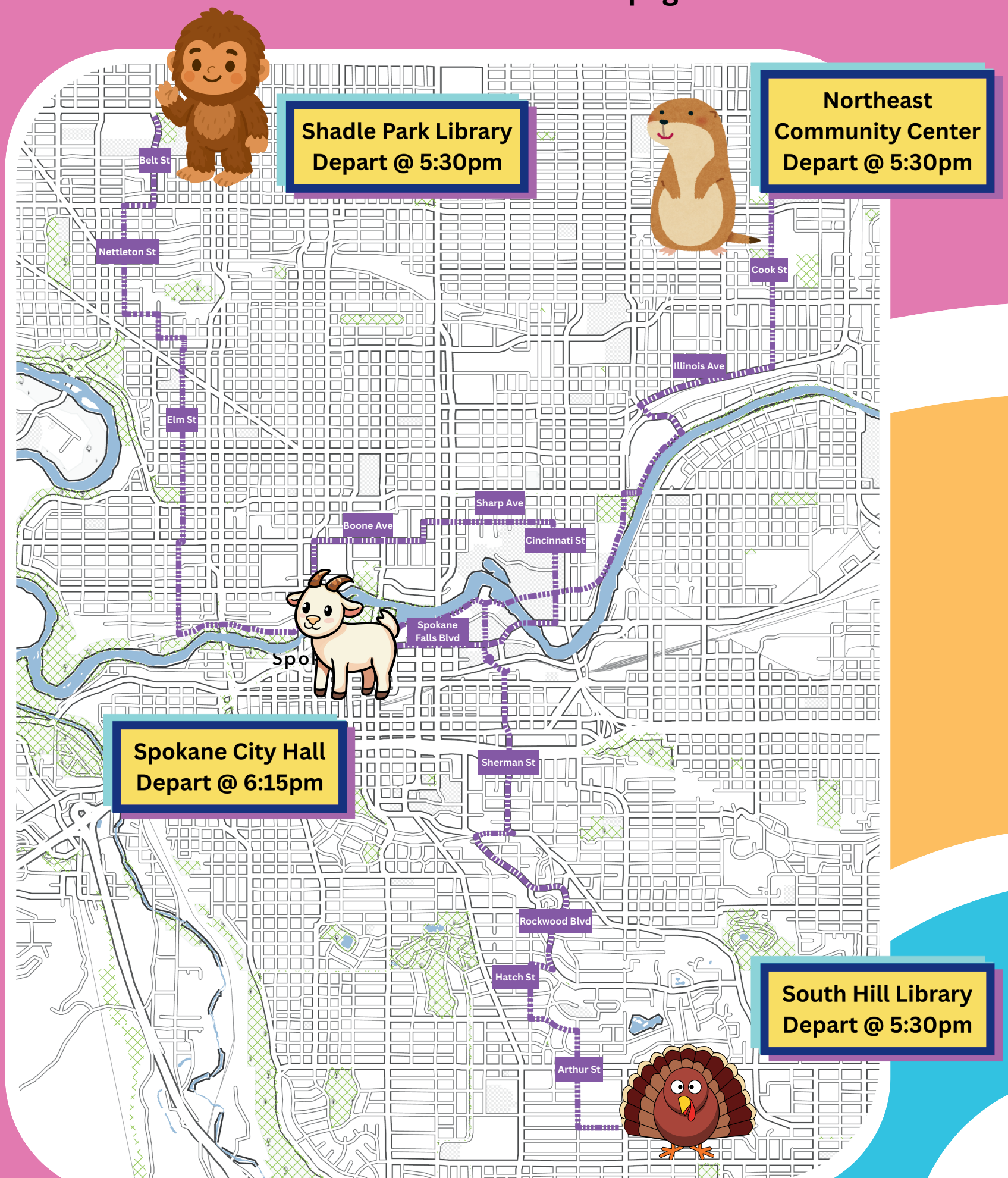


Bicycle Advisory Board Meeting

Each leg of the ride will take off towards City Hall promptly at 5:30pm where we will all meet up at City Hall to do another loop around Downtown at 6:15pm.

Event Details

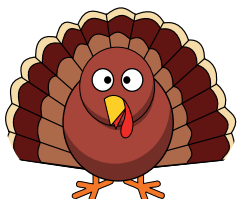
The 'Bigfoot-race' will depart at 5:30pm from near the entrance of Shadle Park Library heading south via Belt, turning right onto Garland and then left onto Nettleton, making way to the pedestrian hybrid beacon crossing NW Blvd @ Elm, then following Elm all the way to the Centennial Trail, and then using the Centennial Trail to arrive at City Hall!



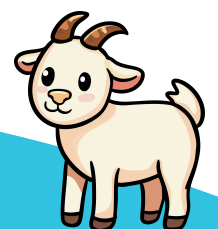
The 'Marmot Meander' will depart at 5:30pm from near the entrance of the Northeast Community Center heading south on Cook St, then turning right onto Illinois Ave, then using the path adjacent to Perry Pl to make way to Centennial Trail, and following Centennial Trail to arrive at City Hall!



The 'Turkey Trot' will depart at 5:30pm from near the entrance of the South Hill Library heading west on 33rd ave, turning right onto Arthur, crossing 29th, making way over to Hatch and then down to Rockwood Blvd, before turning right onto 10th then left on Sherman, following Sherman all the way across the U-District Gateway Bridge, through the Riverpoint Campus, and then heading west on the Centennial Trail to arrive at City Hall!



The 'Goat Trail' will depart at 6:15pm from City Hall (808 W Spokane Falls Blvd) heading north across post street bridge, turning right onto Boone, shifting north via Atlantic to Sharp, following eastbound Sharp until Cincinnati, riding along Cincinnati until Spokane Falls Blvd, and following Spokane Falls Blvd back to City Hall!

This event is to help folks prepare for Week Without Driving which is happening October 1-6, 2026, visit weekwithoutdriving.org for more details. This ride will be during dusk hours so be sure to **bring all of your safety equipment** including reflective clothing/gear and lights on your bicycle! After the group departs from City Hall at approximately 6:15pm it should take roughly 1.5 hours to finish the 'Goat Trail' downtown loop. People are welcome to come and go as the please.
