 - Council approved \$7500 for installing bike racks in downtown Spokane in 2016 and an additional \$7500 for 2017.

- Bicycle Corral process update- Erik Nelson
 - Board members discussed the difficult process imposed by city regulations.
 - Board agrees to take this item back to the council to work through the requirements.
- ➤ Bike share feasibility analysis-Inga Note
 - Discussed the option of participating in a Bike Share pilot program.
 - Discussed how the helmet law may affect this program.
