## **Briefing Session:**

Minutes from the January 19, 2016 meeting were approved unanimously.

## **Public Comment:**

- Sally with the Spokane Bike Club advises that the Spokane Bicycle Club will be organizing the bike to work week. The Bicycle Advisory Board members agree to Co-Sponsor the kick off breakfast at River Front Park.

## **Board Business:**

- Board discussed the four board vacancies and recruitment requirements.

## **Workshops/Presentations:**

- Downtown Bicycle Network Phase III-Brandon Blankenagel
  - Brandon presented an update to the Downtown Bicycle Network and signage options for bike lanes in the downtown area.

Board unanimously makes a motion to recommend sharrows and signage on the full length of both sides of 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave, 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue, and Sprague Avenue to complete the master bike plan. Board also recommends the consideration of a bike lane on 1<sup>st</sup> and Sprague between Maple and Monroe and if funding allows to add sharrows and signage on Bernard south from Sprague to Spokane Falls Blvd. to the City of Spokane City Council.

- Barnes Road Shared Use Lane - Brandon Blankenagel
  - Brandon presented on plans for the Barnes Road downhill shared use lane, uphill bike lane.
  - Questions asked and answered.
  - Discussion ensued.

- Board discussed the BAB 2015 Work Review Summary for Council report.
- Board members worked together to establish a 2016 Work Plan. Work Plan approved.
- Board members discussed the process of obtaining bicycle parking and bicycle corrals and defining a new policy to move forward.
