Falls Avenue Discussion:

- Board discussed erosion on Falls Avenue as well as possible methods of drainage and different options
- ❖ B. Blankenagel: Intersection improvements with storm water line 100K-150K, not paved; grated, smoothed & capturing storm water. Estimated cost to pave falls Ave is 250K-400K
 - CM Stratton provided a packet including photos of the area of discussion, a statement from acting Fire Chief Schaeffer
 - Guests stated their concerns regarding how the narrow road affects access to the fire department and garbage service and river rescues.
 - > CM Stratton: the condition of the road gets worse each year. Sometimes residents have to park at the top of the hill and walk in. She herself has witness untreated storm water flowing right into the river.
- Tom Morgan: The group is able to address certain kinds of street problems. It was questioned whether this problem or reoccurring condition is pertinent to what CTAB dollars are used for. Is this something that the street department is responsible for? CTAB is careful to select projects that are a correct use of TBD money. Pavement preservation is historical purpose of TBD dollars.
 - ➤ G. Holmquist: age of road, safety issues, how long has this road been dirt, bottle neck road, strange & unusual place different than the other 60 miles of unpaved roads; not your average dirt road.
