Climate presentation from Maren Murphy, Planning; How Climate will fold into our Comprehensive Plan update process- Climate will have a shorter chapter, but will be sprinkled in each of the existing chapters; Colin presented on safety data and shared relevance of Safe Streets for All grant; WSDOT having a presentation at Whitworth on the Wye-395 Complete Streets work; North Hamilton from Trent to Spokane Falls has come up-concerns all the way up to North Foothills Drive; Council approved LIME contract and they have to be more responsive to safety concerns or Council can cancel;

2025 current project list is TBD, dependent on Budget changes; want this body to be aware; example is the Unpaved Streets bid that came in so much higher than we thought; Concern about ongoing cost increases past 2025; Could need to come back to this board/others regarding reprioritization if funding cuts are happening; Probably need to build a buffer into project selection due to expanding cuts; No reserve funding for example; Next TBD sidewalk project in NE Hillyard, might need to slow down actual construction; Some of Street dept. funding might cut back from this program as well, and so might need to account for those cuts too;
