



Washington State's Clean Buildings Performance Standard

Helping you navigate CBA requirements & support savings

Clean Buildings Law Overview

- Enacted in 2019, expanded in 2022, and updated in 2023, the CBPS aims to reduce energy use and greenhouse gas emissions in large existing buildings across Washington State.
- Administered by the Department of Commerce, the standard applies to most commercial buildings over 20,000 sq. ft., including multifamily residential buildings.

Deadlines and Penalties



Financial penalties for non-compliance of up to \$5,000+ \$1 per square foot per year annually for Tier 1 or up to \$0.30/square foot for Tier 2



Building Gross Square Footage	Compliance Deadline
Greater than 220,000 square feet	June 1, 2026
Between 90,001-220,000	June 1, 2027
Between 20,000-50,000 including multifamily	June 1, 2027
50,000-90,000	June 1, 2028


