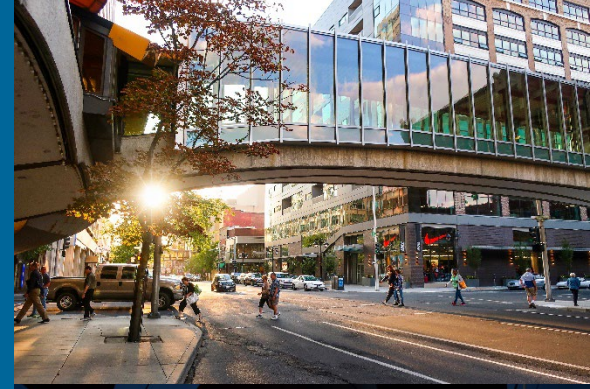




Presented to the City of Spokane Climate Resilience and Sustainability Board
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Washington State 2026 Legislative Session Update

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Budget

- \$540M from CCA used to fill general budget gaps
- Healthy Environment for All (HEAL) funding protected
- Community Forest program funded
- \$4M for Dept. of Natural Resources (DNR) trust land transfers (Jefferson County & Yakama Nation)
- DNR natural areas program not funded
- \$60M in wildfire funding restored
- \$9.8M for Commute Trip Reduction



Clean Energy

Passed:

- 6355 State Transmission Authority
- 2215 Compliance Threshold for Fuel Suppliers
- 2496 More confidentiality for tribes in clean energy siting

Failed:

- 2515 Higher data center standards



Clean Transportation:

Passed:

- 6354 Direct vehicle sales for Electric Vehicles (EV)
- 6309 Light rail permitting
- 6110 Electric-bikes and Electric-motos

Failed:

- 5581 Safe systems approach
- 2134 Requires regional planning to consider Greenhouse Gas reduction
- 2092 Passenger rail advisory committee
- 2722/6262 Heavy vehicles pay their fair share –
Transportation Benefit Districts



Housing:

Passed:

- 2266 STEP (shelters, transitional, emergency, and permanent supportive housing) housing bill
- 5156 Smaller elevators
- 2228 Scissor stairs



Overburdened Communities:

Passed:

- 1903 Low-income energy assistance
- 2338/6223 Supporting community scaled weatherization projects

Failed:

- 1303 Cumulative Risk Burden (CURB) pollution act



Solid Waste:

Passed:

- 2416 Waste to Energy

Failed:

- 2271/6156 Expanding postconsumer recyclables
- 1607/5502 Bottle Deposit Program
- 2233/5965 Better Bag Ban
- 1550/5586 EV battery recycling
- 1420/6174 Textile producer responsibility



Toxics:

Failed:

- 2421/6119 6PPD in tires
