- Longitudinal Systems Analysis (Amanda; HMIS)

Presentation: Project Types; Key Indicators; System Performance Overview, Map; Length of Time Homeless; Exits by Destination Type; Exits by Pathway; Returns to the Homeless System; Returns by Pathway; Demographics: Age, Race, Household Composition; Key Takeaways; Areas of Focus; Resources.

Questions:

Gage – re: youth ages 6-17, could we narrow data down to youth ages 12-17?

Amanada – We are limited within this report but could look further independently from the LSA.

Nicholette – re: fewer people entering system, considering projects included in report how do we draw reasonable conclusions as to why?

Amanda – System Performance Measures will include Street Outreach projects and may be useful to sync. Quarterly Performance Reports show success at individual level. QPR helps draw conclusions when looking at larger systems, including all project types. Maggie – time period also contributes.

Tara – from data perspective, what impact does data quality have?

Amanda – LSA takes several iterations, October HUD opens access, 20% duplication rate w/Anonymous clients, reduction over next two years with work in progress.

Kelly – Pathway mapping impacts how we determine services. Appreciation for work.
