Trees – decomposed granite – comfortable space and suggest smaller trees Lighting and electricity have not been addressed at this time

- Suggested locking electrical box that cannot be broken into to discourage damage and unwanted usage.
  - o Electrical is needed for food trucks, sound systems, festivals
- Access lighting for public safety after completion
  - Discuss with Avista about lighting both sides of the poles (street and sidewalks) for additional light
