# <u>Claims</u>

Hearing Aids—\$5,500

Terri Pfister moved and Dan Brown seconded the motion to approve the reimbursement of \$5,500.00 for hearing aids. The motion passed unanimously.

#### In-home Care Increase — to aprx. \$20,000 per month

Gregory Haff moved and Dan Brown seconded the motion to approve reimbursement up to the current nursing home care limit of \$14,157 per month. The motion passed unanimously.

## 2019 Budget

The Board reviewed analysis of the impact to the Plan of reducing the required contributions from the City of Spokane.

Dan Brown moved Gregory Haff seconded the motion to approve a decrease in the 2019 contributions to \$3,800,000. This decrease will allow the Fire Department to retain firefighters associated with the federal grant for the Alternative Response Unit pilot program.
