# **OPEN SESSION**

# 2020 Investment Performance Report

Hyas Group discussed fixed income markets and the economy broadly, noting the impact the pandemic had on interest rates throughout the year. Reams appears to have navigated the interest rate environment of last year quite well adding a 9.33% return to the benchmark's 6.43% during the year. They were able to effectively take advantage of the swift decline in interest rates as the Federal Reserve took action to stimulate the economy at the initial stages of the pandemic with the severely depressed economic activity. As the economic situation improved later in the year, Reams again was able to participate by adding more credit risk to the portfolio, while taking down some of the interest rate exposure and lowering the duration. In spite of what we consider to be Ream's impressive performance for 2020 and historically, the expectation that the manager will be able to achieve the specified CPI +1.5% actuarial target remains quite low. The average yield to maturity for the portfolio is .9% and the prospective interest and credit risk scenarios is not favorable to the fixed income market generally.

#### Investment Policy

The Board engaged in its annual review of the Fund's Investment Policy Statement (IPS). Hyas Group had no suggested changes at this time.

Clive Jones moved and Dan Brown seconded the motion to approve the investment policy as presented. The motion pass unanimously.

#### **Review of Holdings**

Hyas Group did speak to the fact that during 2020 the Fund did hold two American Airline securities that were rated below the required investment grade standard. Policy does permit the holding of such securities so long as the Board approves of such. While the securities remained in the portfolio at year-end, they were subsequently sold in February 2021, so no action was necessary.

### Hearing Aids \$5,000
