Claims

<u>Therapeutic Massage—\$1,600</u>

Dave Anderson moved and Mark Grumbly seconded the motion to approve the reimbursement of \$1,600 for therapeutic massage treatments. The motion passed unanimously.

Lift Chair—various bids

Dave Anderson moved and Mark Grumbly seconded the motion to approve reimbursement of a lift chair at the cost of no more than \$1,169.90. The motion passed unanimously.

2019 Budget

Dave Anderson moved and Mark Grumbly seconded the motion to approve the 2019 budget with an increase to contractual services. The motion passed unanimously.

July COLA

Mark Grumbly moved and Dave Anderson seconded the motion to grant a 3.5% COLA effective July 1, 2018. The motion passed unanimously.

Dave Anderson moved and Mark Grumbly seconded the motion to update the Board Rules to automatically approve the July COLA that is required by RCW 41.26.250. The motion unanimously.
