<u>Friends of Palisades:</u> Paul Lindholdt reported that they had their most successful cleanup event. The Friends and volunteers removed over 10 tons of refuse from the area! Also, botanist Rebecca Brown will lead a wildflower hike on June 11 at 7:00 p.m. Meet at the parking lot at the intersection of Greenwood Rd and Basalt St.

<u>Friends of Manito:</u> In Kelly's absence, Jennifer reported that the Friends are looking for volunteers for the Spring plant sale on June 1 and for the Art Fest on June 8.

<u>Friends of the Bluff:</u> Jeff Lambert reported that 35 artists are taking part in Brush on the Bluff this year. The event is at Polly Judd Park on Saturday, May 18, from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and there will be fun activities and art projects by Greenplay for children. Approximately 1,500 people attended the event last year. Polly Judd Park is located at 14th Ave & the Bluff.

The Friends are having an art event at Barrister Winery on Friday, May 24. Painting are sold at online auction and the artists and the Friends each receive 50% of the proceeds.

Interpretive signs are being placed and a kiosk is going in at Polly Judd.

The Friends are working with Angel Spell to get bids for their Rocket Gulch stairs project. Jennifer suggested the Eagle Scouts; however, the project is steep and involved and will require a licensed contractor.
