Discounts

Largest qualifying discount will be applied. Multiple discounts may not be applied with exception of 10% discount for multi-year agreements.

- 1. Community Event² Discounts
 - *25% Event is free and open to the public; OR,
 - *20% Public fundraiser (fun run, entrance fees, etc.); OR,
 - *15% Nonprofit Private Event
- 2. 50% Discount off of facility rates for new events to Riverfront Park/Pavilion. Applied to first event only and requires 3-year agreement.
- 3. 60% Multi-Day Discount Event reservations greater than four days. Each day after four receives the discount.
- 4. Additional 10% for event with a min 3 year agreement. \$2000 mininum rental

Footnotes

- 1. Flat rate or 10% of gross gate receipts, per performance, whichever is greater.
- 2. Community Event Events that are promoted or sponsored by a Civic, Educational, Religious or Charitable group or organization within the State of Washington. The group must hold a City of Spokane business license (unless exempt by SMC regulations)
- 3. Commercial Performance/Event Defined as public or private sector (excluding city agency or nonprofit organization).
- 4. 4-hour and full day (6am-Midnight) rates are inclusive of move-in and move-out periods for events.
- 5. Prices do not include, where applicable, Sales (9.0%) and Admission tax
