The ponderosa pine (Pinus ponderosa) located within the 23rd Ave public right-of-way (in the planting strip) abutting 2225 S. Manito Blvd is of significant size (48dbh), one of the largest pines in town meets program criteria for consideration. The adjacent property owners (Travers) have endorsed the nomination.





An outstanding, large and healthy specimen of this somewhat rarely planted maple species in Spokane. This maple species has bark reminiscent of large sycamore trees (Platanus spp.), hence its common name. MAP: The tree is located on private property, about 200 ft north of the corner of W. 11th & S. Adams St. and a little east of the City sidewalk along Adams. Photo attached.

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
