**SAGA:** \$38,500 granted this round with more than \$100,000 granted during 2019. The Spokesman Review is writing up an article about the new grantees. City Council has unanimously approved \$100,000 more over the next three years (as part of a larger \$375,000 grant).

SAGA goals for next year include more funding to individual artists, direct outreach to other disciplines such as fashion, culinary and art therapy. Dec 11th next grant workshop.

**Programming:** Professional development survey is out; please encourage artists to submit input. Events for next year are being planned.

Poet laureate updates: Chris Cook has already been actively doing a lot of events; his info will be up on website soon
