- Shelly answered commissioner questions about the SAGA application and funding process.
- Julie Shepherd was the commissioner on the application review committee for this round. She shared her reflections of her time one the committee.

Guest Presentation - Creative Economy: Hillyard to Greater Region (Darya Pilram)

- Darya is a Economic Recovery Corps Fellow. The program is funded by CARES Act funding. GSI and CdA EDC co-applied to bring a fellow to the region. It's a 2.5-year program. One of 65 in the country. This is the only one focused specifically on the Creative Economy.
- Part of Darya's work is to establish Creative Districts in the region. Creative Districts are a state-level designation that take a lot of planning and work to do.
- Hillyard is getting ready to apply for Creative District status. Garland is also applying, and Darya is working with both neighborhoods.
- Darya gave a presentation with an overview of the Creative Economy locally, state-wide, and nationally, and the initiatives she's working on through her Fellowship.
