On <u>December 2013</u> Jamie Pendleton of Pendleton Enterprises after discussing the possibilities of increasing the capacity of the space at 121 N wall Street from the assembly capacity issued to the previous tenant Biegnets.

Spokane Fire said it was possible to increase the capacity and made suggestions on what floor plan would get a capacity of 129 and removing tables and chairs would get the Maximum load up to 224.

Exhibit 1 (floor Plan)

Pendleton's 12 year lease was contingent on the fire and other city required permits. Pendleton made a investment into business in downtown Spokane based on this information.

Pendleton used this information to apply for the Places of Assembly Permit with Spokane Fire on 12/19/2013 which is issued on 1/19/14.

Pendleton's business Spokane Downtown Daiquiri Factory is issued the license 1/19/2014

Exhibit 4 (Spokane Downtown Daiquiri Factory Places of Assembly License)

Spokane Downtown Daiquiri Factory is wrongfully evicted from the premises by Landlord June 2014.

Spokane Superior Court reinstates Spokane Downtown Daiquiri Factory's lease **March 2016** and Pendleton Enterprises reapplies for the business license.

This requires a renewal of the application. Nothing has changed in the space. It is simply reopening.

During the application process Nathan Mulkey Fire Marshall of Spokane Fire claims that he can not grant a double occupancy, claiming that it isn't done any more because so many bars violated it in the past. City no city municipal code or rules stating such, but clearly providing it as a excuse to prejudice the renewal application so he can alter the maximum capacity already completed by Shannon on 12/19/13 Nathan has no justified reason to prejudice the business for having the same assembly double occupancy as provided by the City of Spokane in 2013.

This is a violation of Section N of the Ethics Code:

N. Commission of Acts of Moral Turpitude or Dishonesty Prohibited.

No City officer or employee shall commit any act of moral turpitude or dishonesty relating to his or her duties or position as a City officer or employee or arising from business with the City. Conviction of a felony or a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude or dishonesty, the nature of which demonstrates lack of fitness for the position held, shall be considered conclusive evidence of a violation of this Code of

Ethics. Demonstrated acts of moral turpitude or dishonesty are not limited to felony or misdemeanor criminal convictions

Spokane Daiquiri has never been cited for capacity violations. The business has only been accused of them by Lisa Jones City of Spokane Fire Marshall subject of another ethics complaint in regards to the business in another matter. There is no reason in the code or reason to not grandfather the business who has always been in compliance and never cited for over capacity and has signed a 12 year lease using the expertise of Spokane Fire's original estimates. Nathan Mulkey refuses to acknowledge these facts that are clearly part of Spokane Fire Departments records and proceeds to state a new walk thru has to be done to decide the new occupancy load for the space. Nathan Mulkey was fully aware of our compliance and the 2013 granted capacity for that he was dispatched to safety inspect himself on 2/28/2014 and 3/16/2014

Exhibit 5 (City Of Spokane Permit Work Flow Comments)

Nathan explains that other business in Spokane have been allowed to remain grandfathered to their double occupancy licenses but provides no clear reason why we are now forced to continue with a Maximum Occupancy now determined by City Planning Department Dean Giles & Nathan Mulkey to now be 164 after previously being granted a maximum total of 224. The sidewalk patio café permit capacity has been cut in ½ and the neighboring tenant has a higher patio capacity for the same size patio. Nathan Mulkey and Dean Giles provides no clear reason or SMC why these previous calculations calculated by City of Spokane Fire Department should now be changed and not grandfathered. Creating a total loss of 60 people to the business occupancy. Dean Giles, and Nathan Mulkey provide no clear factual reasons why they have chosed to prejudice the business assembly license capacity granted in 2013 but have took great effort in doing so.


Exhibit 6 (City Of Spokane Fire Assembly Permit granted in 2016)
