
COMPLAINANT'S REQUESTS TO
EXTEND SUBPOENA DEADLINE

The Claimant, Thomas Bassler, requests that the Ethics Commission waive the current deadline for the submission of proposed witness subpoenas of August 10, and extend the deadline to October 19, 2022, or to such other date as the Commission determines to be appropriate. The undersigned was only recently retained to represent the Complainant in these proceedings, which was after the August 10 subpoena deadline had already passed. Also, in the Commission's Second Amended Pre-Hearing Order entered on September 7, 2022, all the previous, pre-hearing scheduling deadlines were adjusted according to the new hearing date of October 26, 2022, except the deadline to submit proposed subpoenas, which appears to have been oversight given that the Order was entered after the deadline.
