Ethics Commission's Dismissal of Complaint filed by
Anthony Proctor against Anthony Proctor

FINDINGS

The Ethics Commission makes the following findings:

1. The City Clerk's Office received a complaint on June 16th, 2026 filed by Anthony Proctor.
2. Mr. Proctor filed his complaint on the correct form with the City Clerk's Office.
3. On page 1 of the complaint, Mr. Proctor listed himself as the person believed to have violated the City Code of Ethics.
4. Mr. Proctor is not an employee of the City of Spokane.
5. This complaint appears to have been filed incorrectly and does not meet the requirements of SMC 1.04B.140 (A) by identifying the City official or employee to have engaged in prohibited conduct.
6. The complaint does not state any specific provision of SMC 1.04B that is alleged to have been violated.

DISMISSAL

Based upon the Findings set forth above the Ethics Commission Chair summarily dismisses the complaint. Under SMC 01.04B.200(A)(1), this complaint shall be summarily dismissed because the respondent is not subject to the Code of Ethics.
