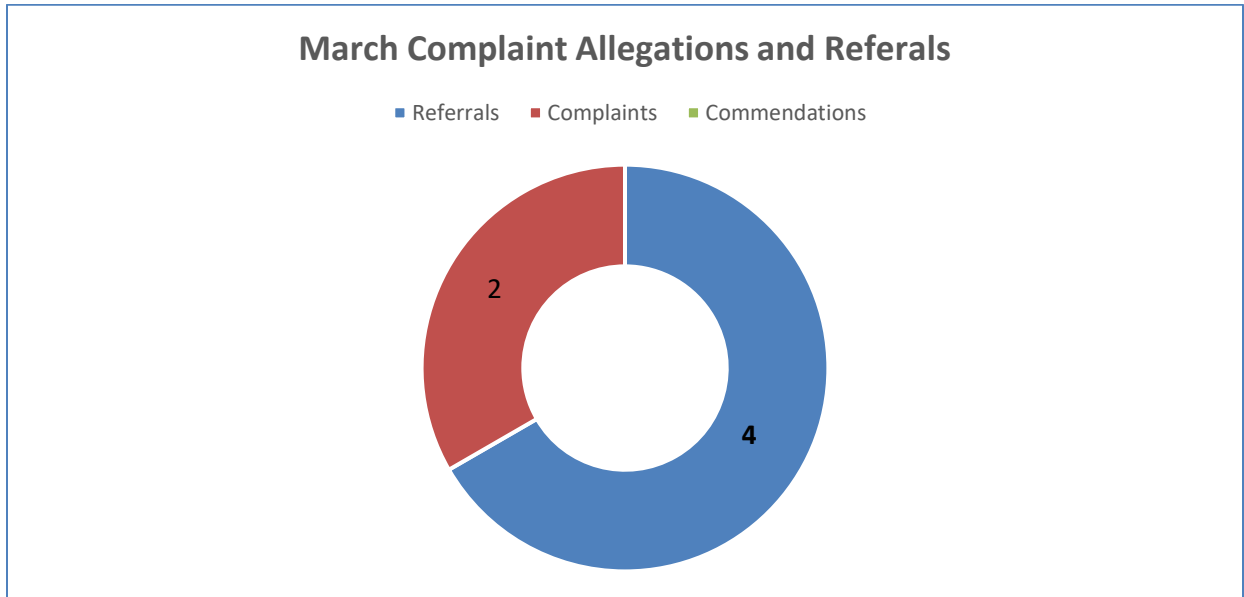

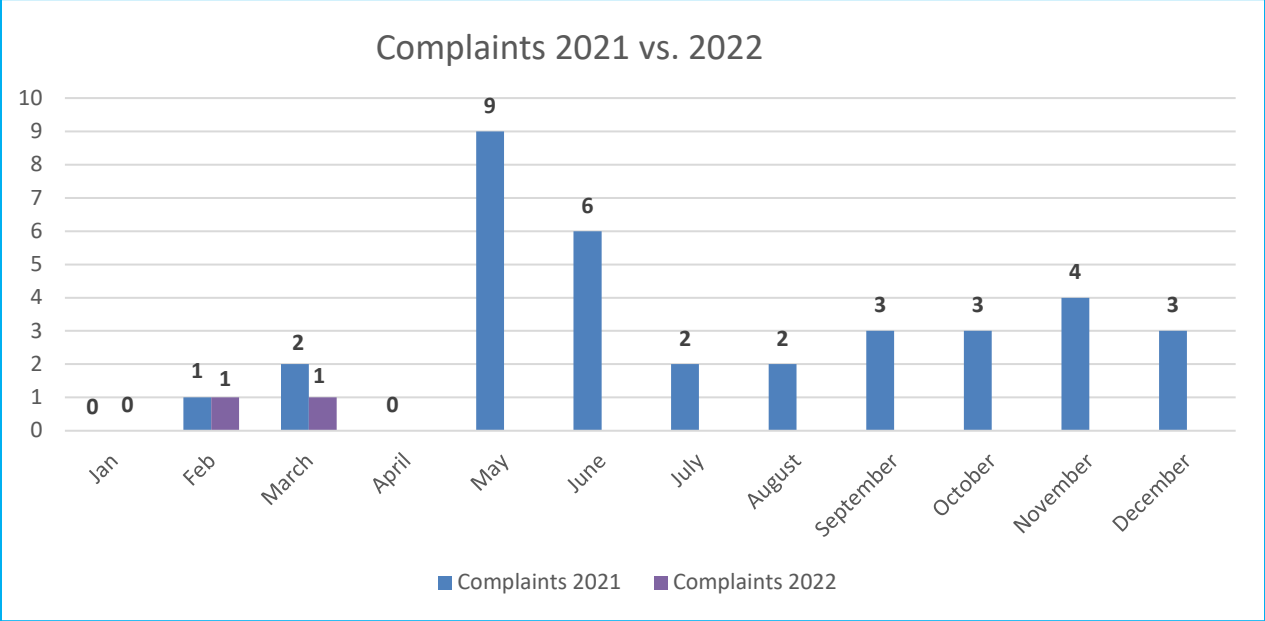
Complaints/Referrals/Contacts



Highlights:

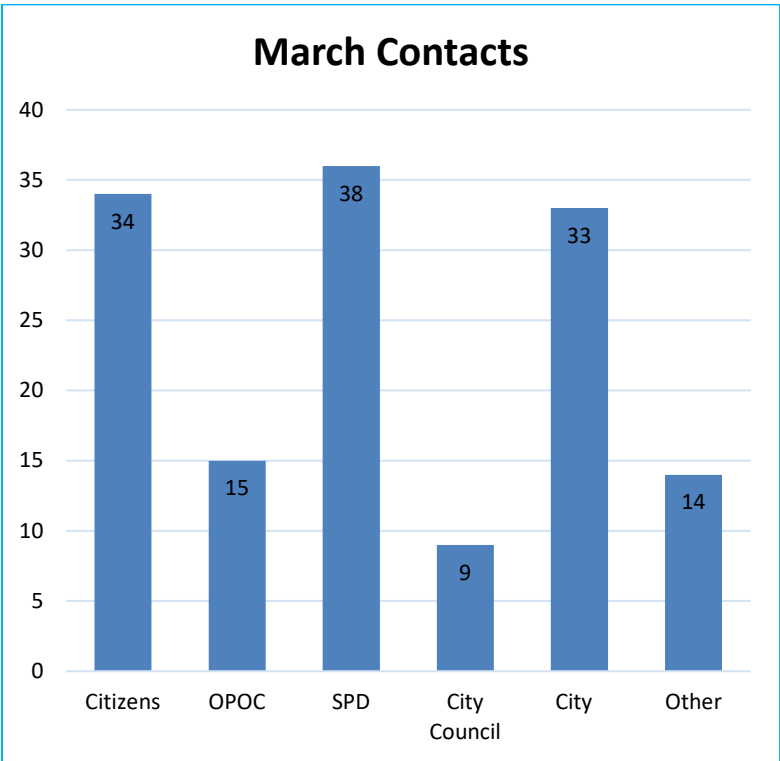
In March, the Office of the Police Ombudsman (OPO) submitted 2 Complaints to Internal Affairs and made 4 Referrals to various offices and agencies.

- OPO 22-03: A community leader witnessed a member of SPD speeding through a school zone.
- OPO 22-04: A community member complained about a traffic stop conducted by an officer for not wearing their seatbelt. In addition, the complainant alleged that the officer stated that they had conducted an inspection on the community members commercial vehicle, but did not conduct the inspection.
- IR 22-08: A community member had concerns regarding their complaint they submitted in 2019; this was referred to SPD/IA.
- ER 22-09: A community member had been trying to get their Public Records fulfilled; this was referred to the Police Records Department.
- ER 22-10: A community member was frustrated with an alleged lack of follow through from SPD; this was referred to the Police Chief's Office.

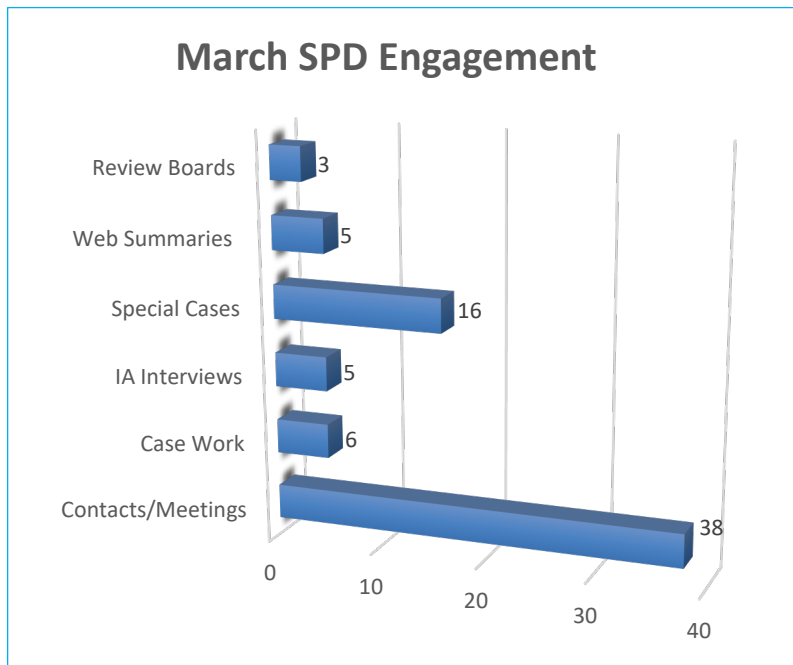

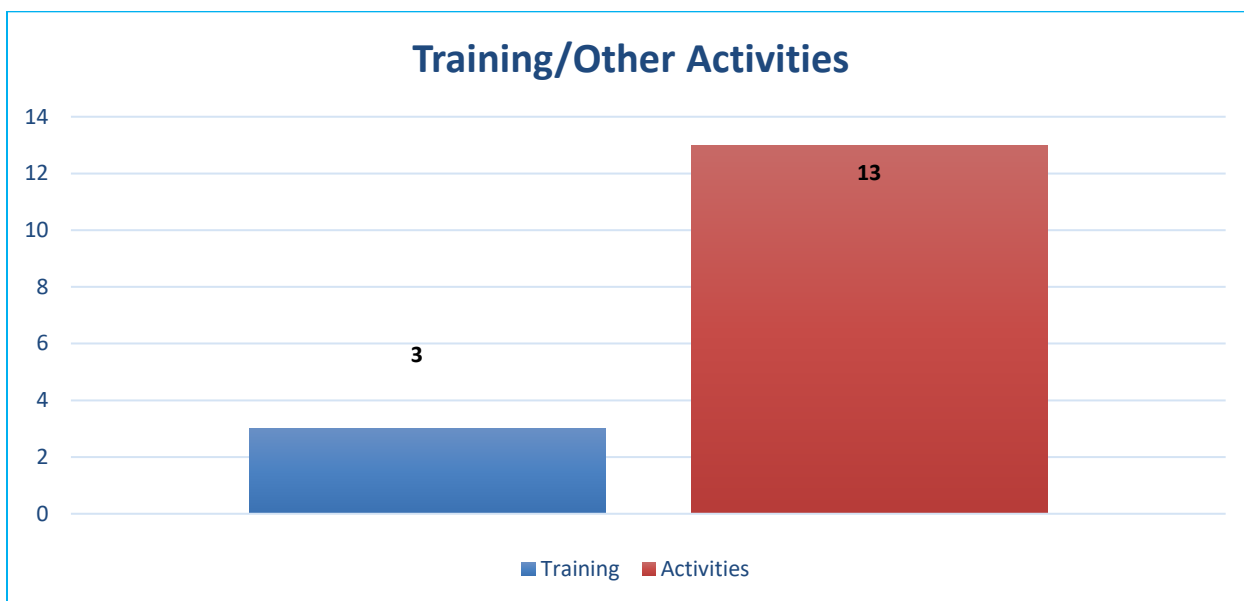
