 - Finally, Spencer mentioned that the City had recently allocated funds for a wildfire modeling software package that would allow the City to model both wildland fire and evacuation scenarios. He reported that the software would primarily be for the Emergency Management

department's use but that the Planning Department hoped to use it when considering Wildland Urban Interface (WUI) hazards.
