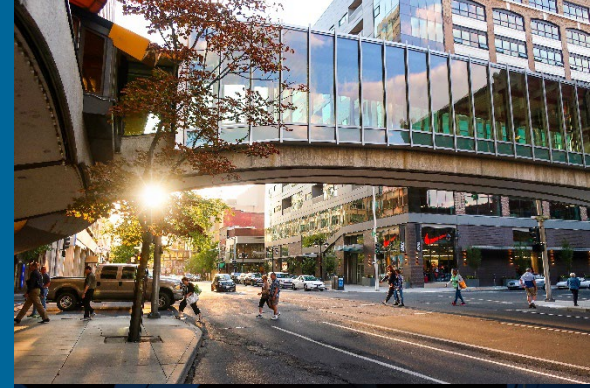

# What is a School Street?

A school street is a street near a school building or campus that is temporarily or permanently closed to vehicle traffic during certain hours such as pick-up and drop-off.



# What are School Streets?

Full closure

Access limited to  
emergency vehicles

Limited closure

Limited to local access  
vehicular traffic



# What are the benefits of School Streets?

NYC, NY

- Safer roads for all users through vehicle access restrictions
- Encourage active transportation
- Local reductions in air pollution
- Better organization of pickup and drop-off
- Permanent school streets can provide additional outdoor learning and activity spaces for students

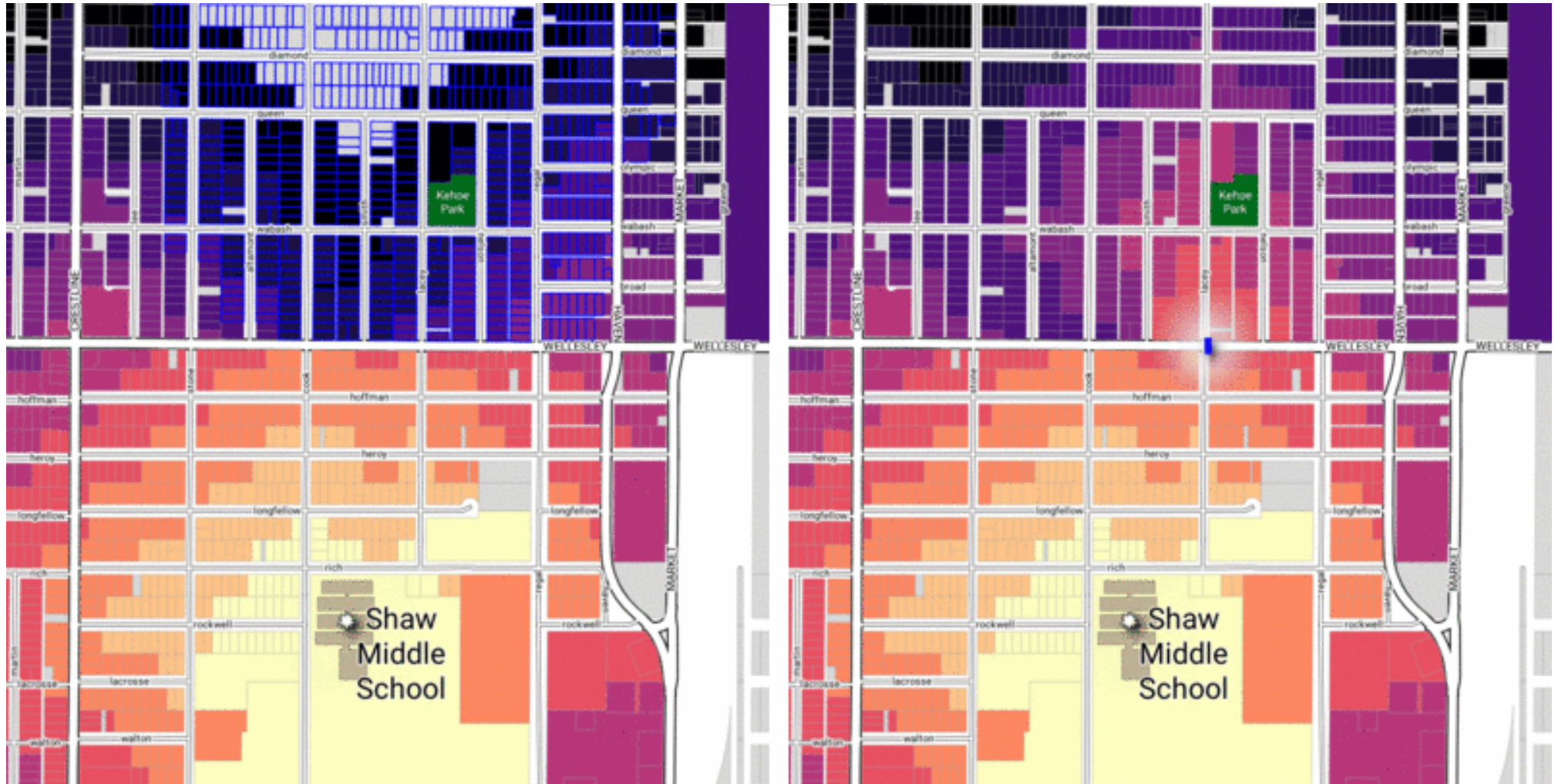
# Where are School Streets?

- Philadelphia, Pennsylvania – Pilot Program
- International – More than 500 school streets established since 2019
