Brandon Blankenagel presented an update on the City's Lime Bikes pilot project. Noted in his presentation was total mileage (over 100,000) travelled by the three type of vehicles used, and feedback results from the public. Within the feedback from the public were the top reasons that respondents did not use it 1) "Not enough bike lanes or trails" and 2) "bikes and/or scooters not located where I want them", and the top reasons why they did use them: 1) "fun to ride with friends/family" and 2) "Wanted to try it".

Members of the committee noted that there was a wide dispersion of use of the program, that they contributed to the vitality of downtown, and generally that the committee was favorable to shared mobility.
