Standing Items, Updates, and Reports:

Discussions and Presentations:

Modii Presented a PowerPoint for what Modii can do for Spokane

Modii- is a mobility platform designed for Smart Cities

- Can provide a unified brand identity
- Modii starts by using digitized parking technology to create a visual, time-dynamic inventory of parking assets- interactive, personalized for curbside, surface lots and garages.
- Modii can work with our GIS map and allow for many layer options (Free parking, paid parking, Disabled parking, Motorcycle only, EV dedicated
- Customer Dashboard can provide us live occupancy/locations, durations, session times

Improved North Bank Parking

Can we come up with agreements (Shared Parking) with these vendors? Daily parking- use of these facilities in the evening, theater off-street parking

- RockPoint- likes the idea for after hours and weekends managed by Rockpoint ownership. 300-400 spaces available

Parking system revenue and operations update:

- 180 New Poles for Parking Meters were approved; poles will be cut to meet ADA standards. We will be installing using flanges for easier installation/replacement.
- We have ordered 50 solar-compatible meter covers for Special Loading Zone Reservation, identifying guidelines for pilot area.
- We have been providing Courtesy notice for citizens with visible Disabled Placard. 4-hour “Free Parking” maximum in 2-hour and 4-hour areas, then must move to different blockface. 4-hour “Free Parking” in All Day areas, then must pay for remaining time

New/Old Business: The PAC has (2) vacant positions on the Committee.
