Why

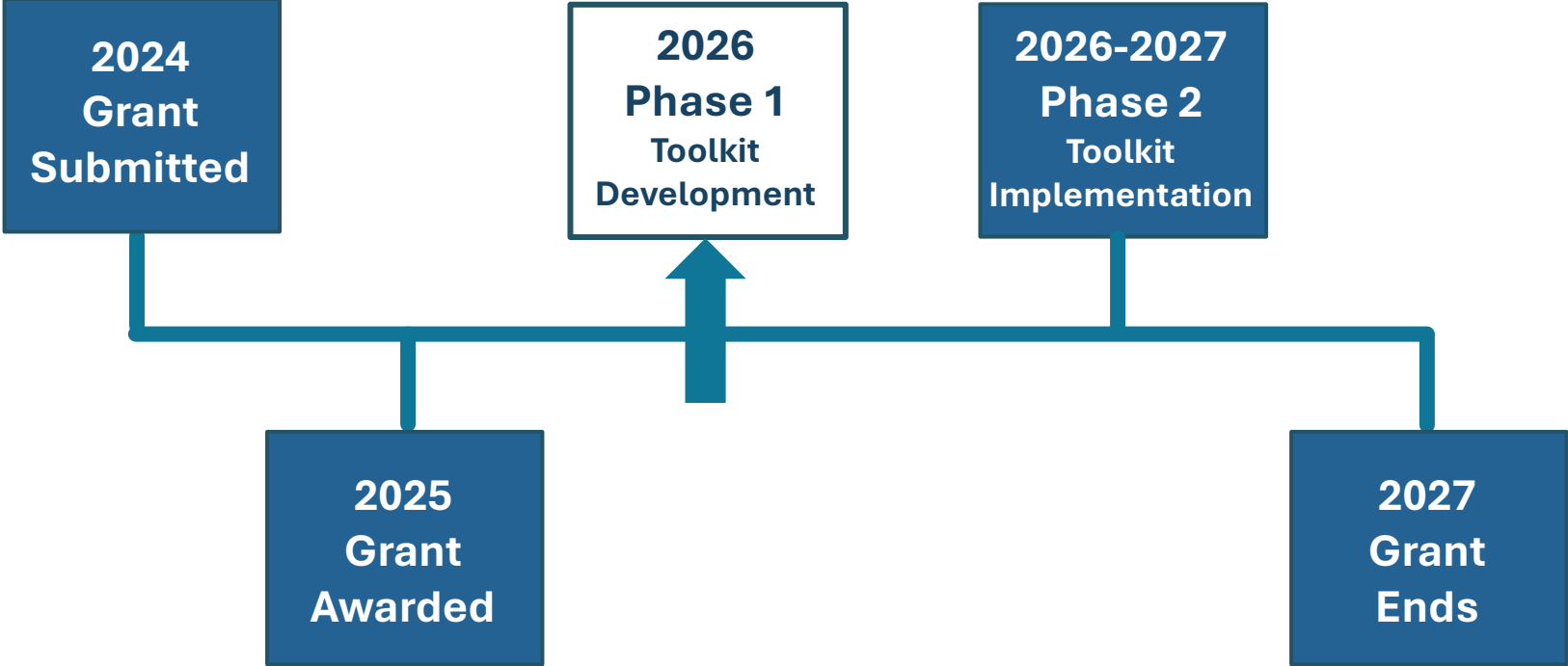
- Stormwater management **systems and communities are unique**

Education & Outreach Grant Timeline



Consultant Contract – Phase 1

Procurement

- City's Procurement Department Process
- Steering Committee = City of Spokane (2), City of Spokane Valley, and Spokane County
- 14 proposals submitted and scored by committee
- Selected four to interview in-person

Deliverables

- Campaign development based on Stormwater Group priorities
- Branding and Messaging – Language accessibility
- Toolkit Design and Contents – Community engagement, digital, print, etc.

Cost

- Request for Proposal – Not to exceed \$150,475
- Draft Consultant Contract - \$144,730
