# Mobile Food Vending Updates

Eliminates City regulatory licensing fee and registration requirement

Eliminates provision that requires a vendor have “written record” from an adjoining private property owner when vending in the public right of way

Allows mobile food vendors to operate in any surface parking lots with permission from the lot operator without requiring site improvements

Maintains 50-foot restaurant buffer and defines restaurant
