

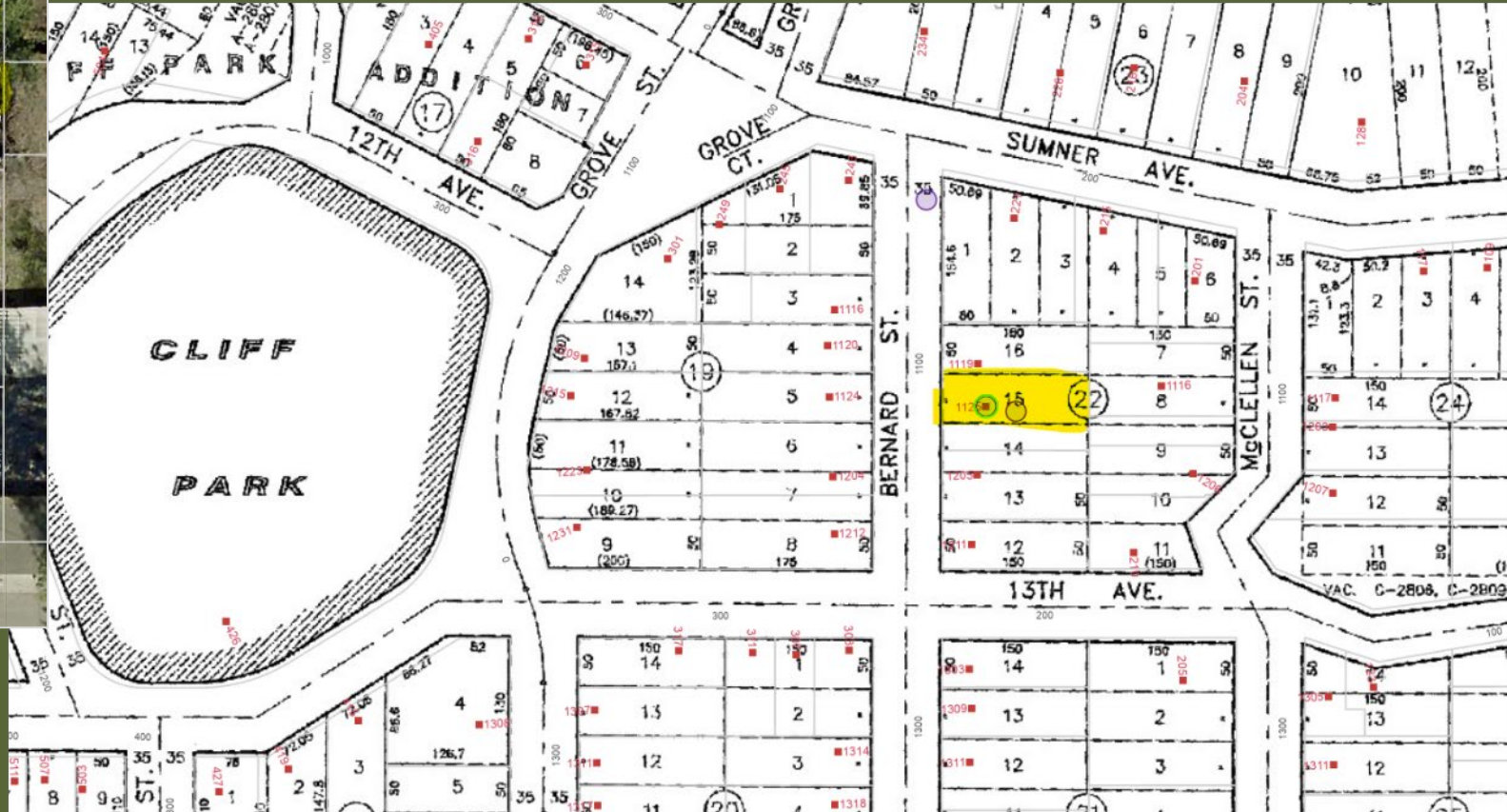

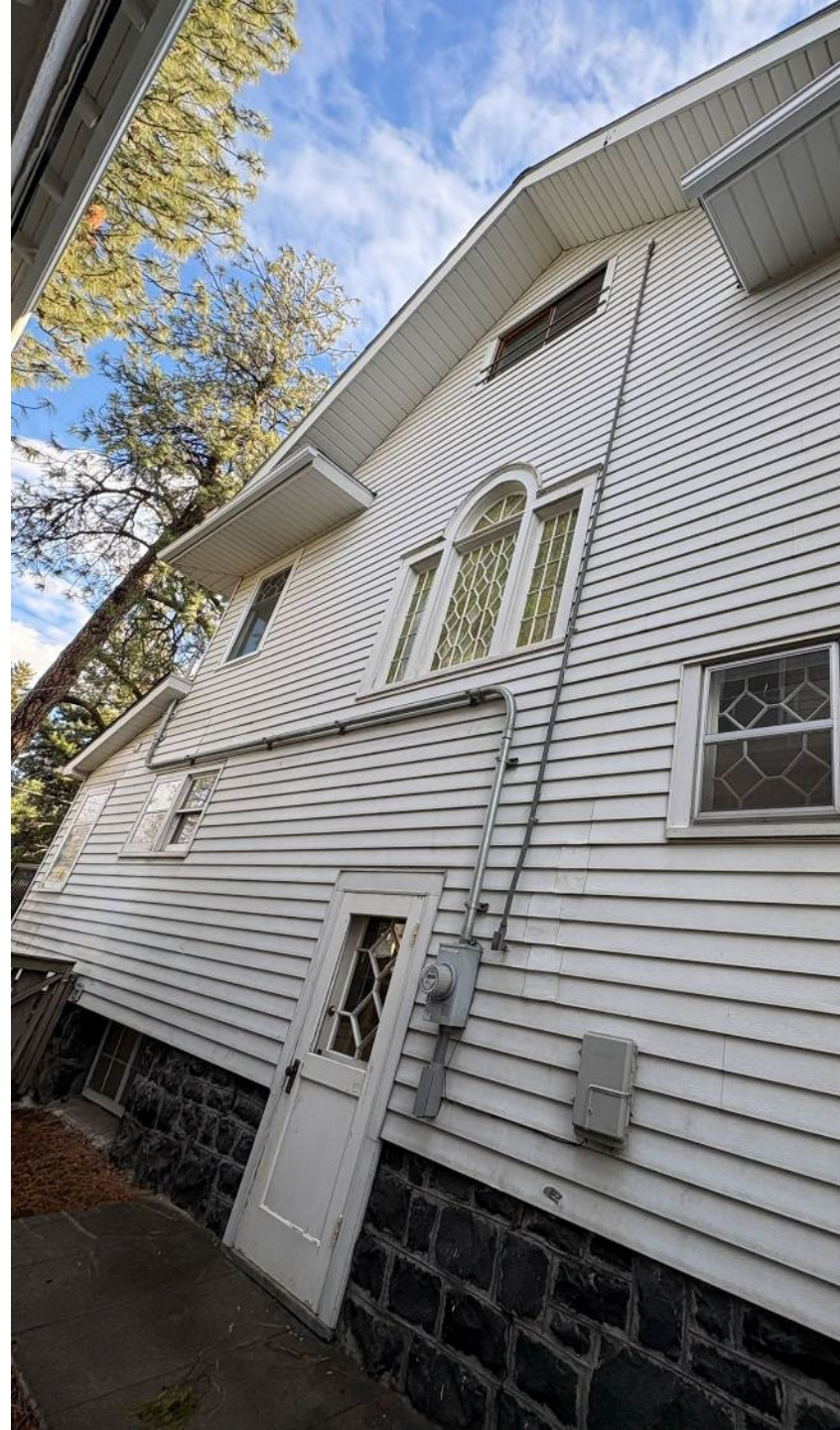
*New Home in Cliff Park, on Bernard Street, Near Cliff Avenue, Bought by Matt Baumgartner for \$15,000*

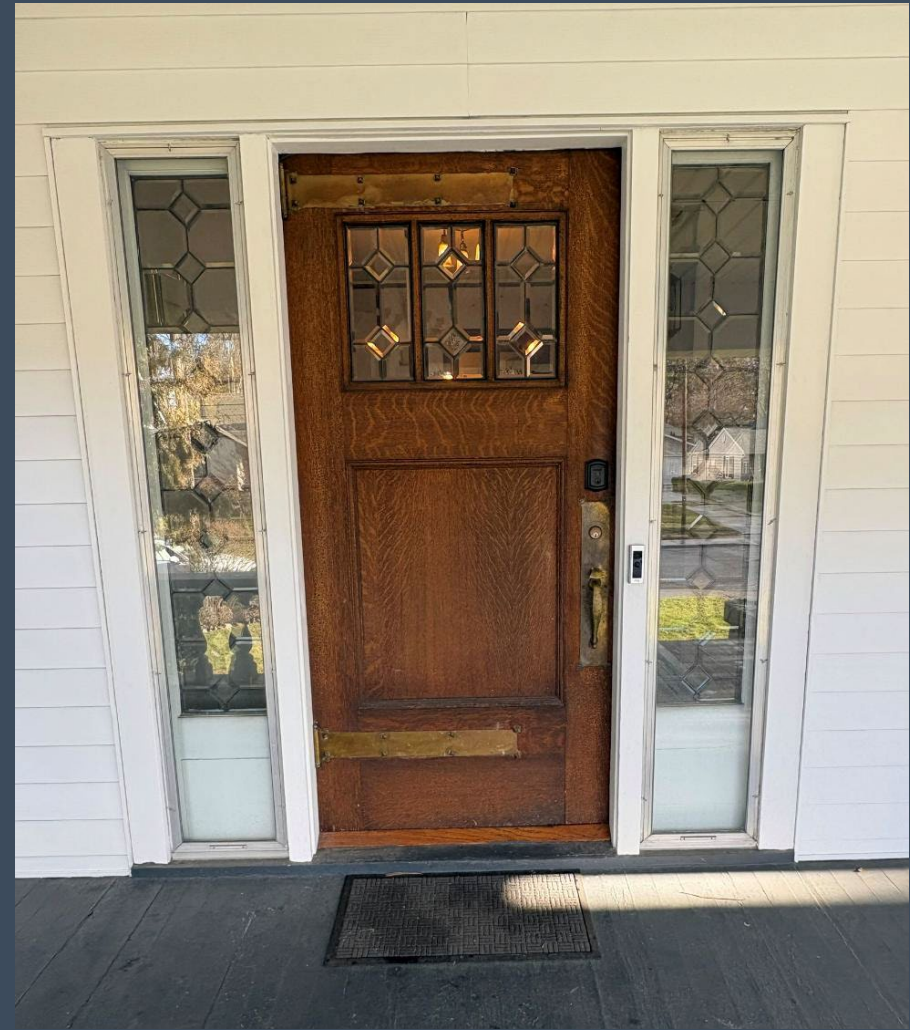


The above is a picture of the eight-room modern house of Colonial type built by Contractor A. T. Johnson and sold to Mr. Baumgartner last week for \$15,000. The deal was negotiated by J. Melvin Thomas. The house was designed by Architect Earl W. Mor-

risson and is on a lot 50x150 feet on Bernard near Cliff avenue. The house is finished in oak on the lower floors with white enamel finish in the kitchen and birch on the second floor. All floors are of hardwood. Besides the eight rooms on the two main floors there are two rooms finished off in the attic.

There are many features in the construction, including a built-in sideboard, fireplace, beamed ceilings, bathrooms with tiled floors and wainscoting, tile floor in the vestibule, bevel plate mirrors and a basement finished with a laundry, fuel room, fruit room and a furnace room. Mr. Baumgartner will occupy the house as a home.







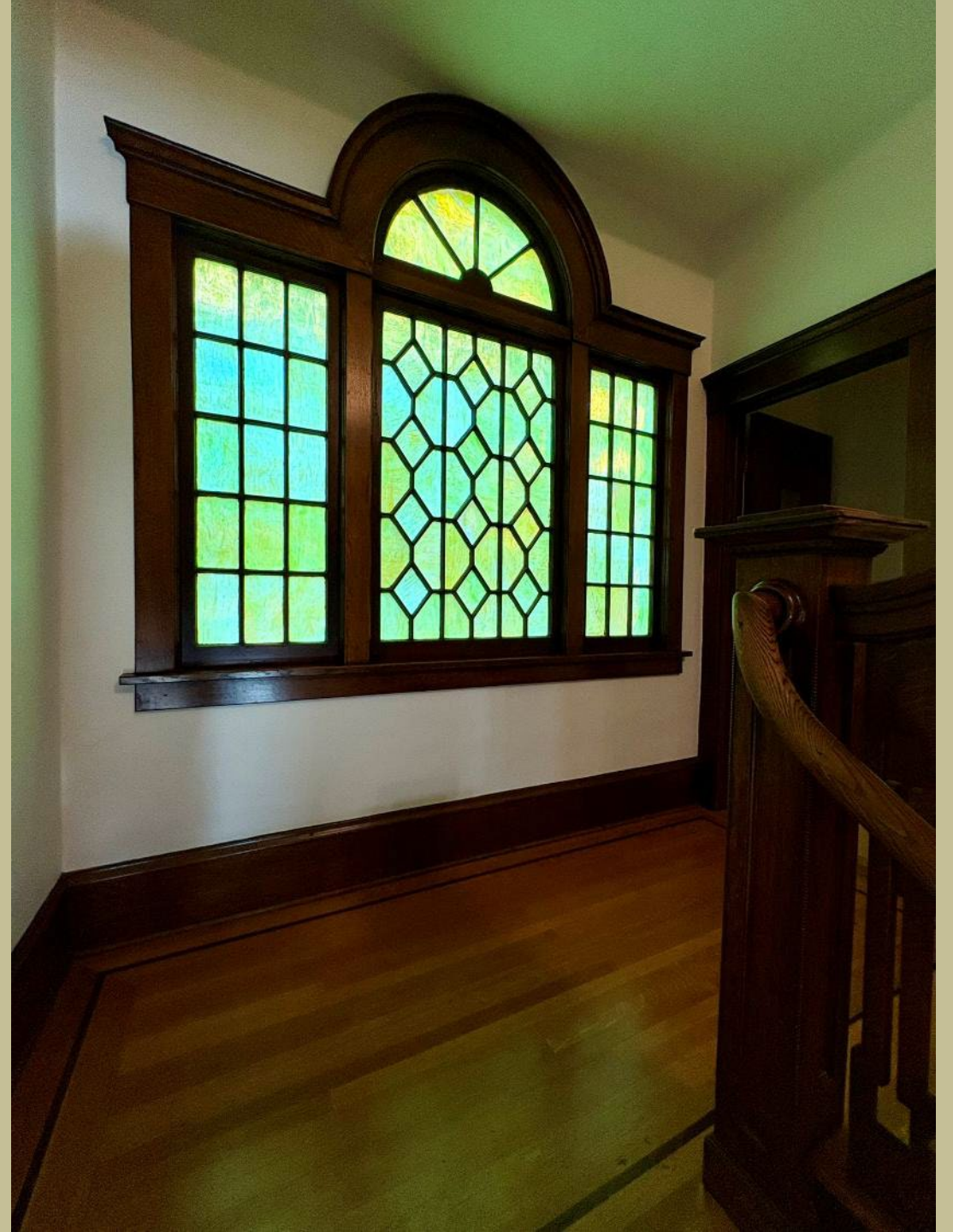


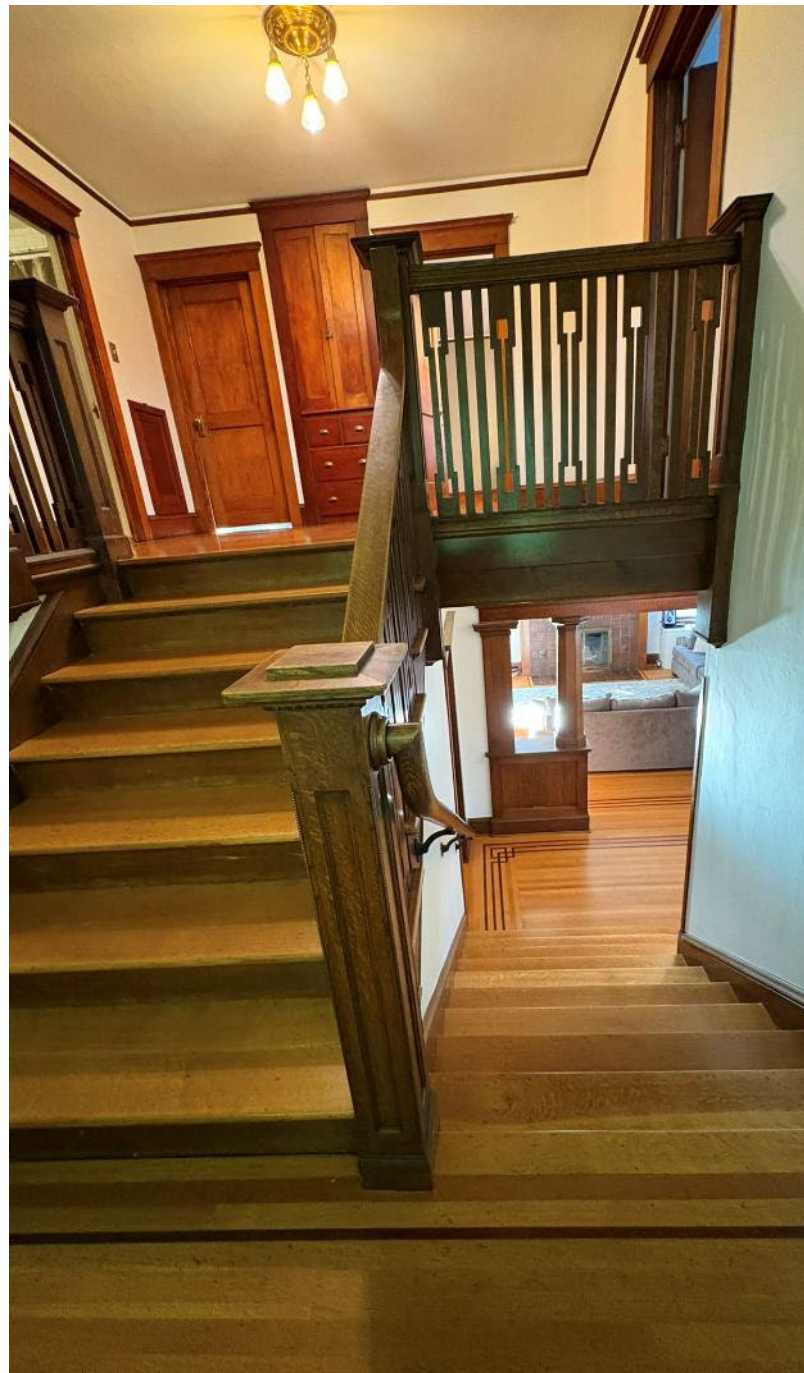
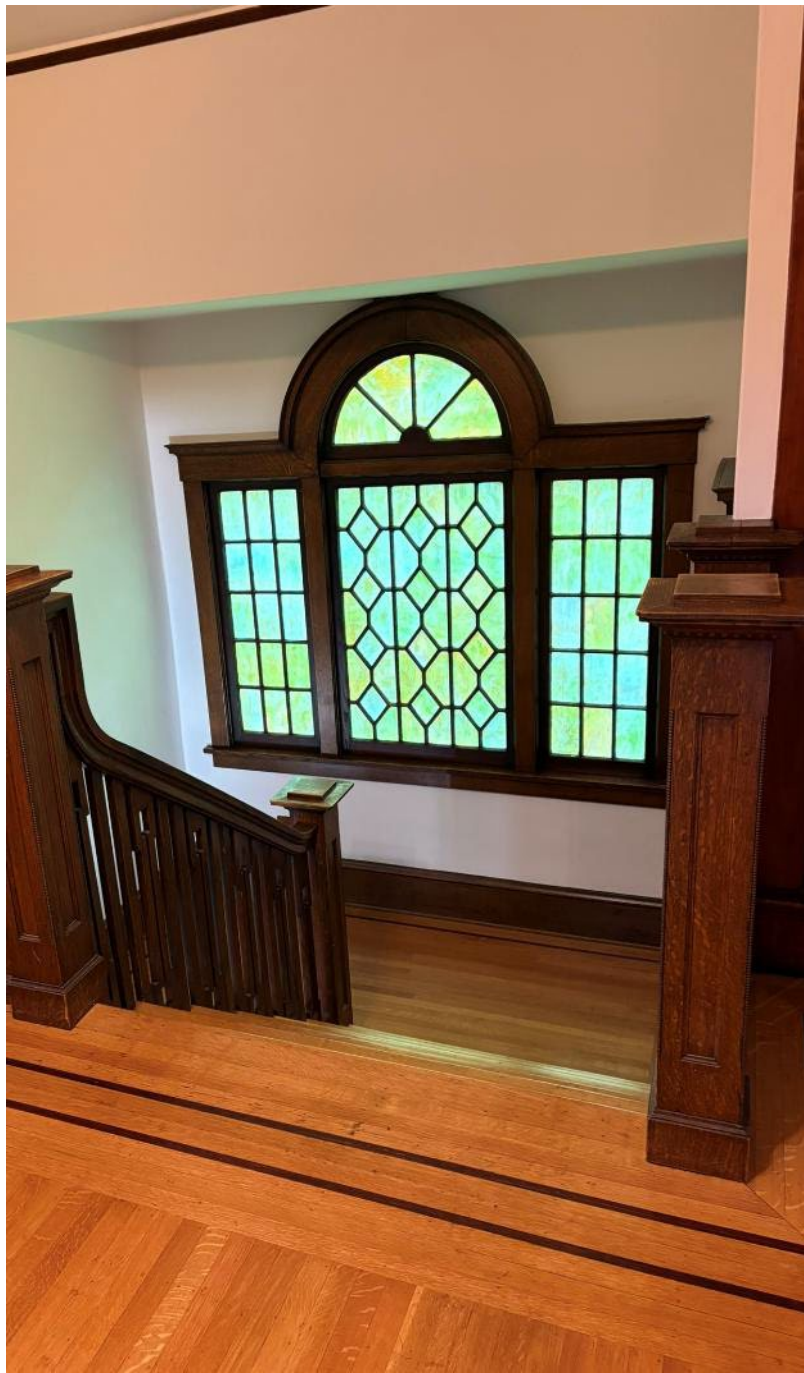
















AMIL T. & HANNA JOHNSON with their grandchildren

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# PIONEER MINING MAN SUCCUMBS

Matt Baumgartner, Operator in  
Coeur d'Alenes, Dies After  
Brief Illness.

Matt Baumgartner, 62, well-known mining man and early settler here, died Tuesday night at a local hospital after a brief illness. His home was at S1125 Bernard and he main-

tained offices in the Lindelle building.

A native of Germany, where he was educated at a school of mines, Mr. Baumgartner came to this country as a young man, locating first in California, where he mined for two years, and then was engaged as a chemist-assayer in San Francisco. He came to the Coeur d'Alenes in the early '90s after spending a short time in Arizona, Colorado and Montana. He came to Spokane about 20 years ago.

Mr. Baumgartner was interested in properties around Burke and was at one time president of the Liston Mining company. He was a life member of the Washington branch of the American Mining congress. Of late he has been operating a property near the Sunshine mine.

For many years Mr. Baumgartner was active in the affairs of the mining conventions, helping to prepare the programs.

He is survived by his widow, Mary F.; one daughter, Kathleen at the home; three brothers in Germany. He belonged to the Elks' lodge. The body is at Hennessey & Calloway's.

Funeral services will be held Saturday morning at 10 o'clock from St. Augustine's church, the Rev. Father Condon officiating. Rosary will be said at the home Friday evening at 8 o'clock. Burial will be in Holy Cross cemetery.
