West Quadrant TIF Neighborhood Project Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes

April 5, 2023

Committee Members Present: Fran Papenleur (Vice-Chair), Kelly Cruz, Amanda Richardson, EJ Ianelli, Vickie Munch, Alan Chatham, Michael Pflieger. Absent: Kimberly Lawrence (Chair)

Staff Present: Kevin Freibott (staff liaison), Steve MacDonald (Division Director), Tim Thompson (Principal Planner), Colin Quinn-Hurst (Senior Planner)

The meeting began at 4:02 PM.

- 1. Welcome and Introductions Introductions were made. No action was taken.
- 2. **Approval of Meeting Minutes** The minutes for January were presented. A motion was made to approve the January minutes as presented by Mr. Cruz and passed (S: Mr. Ianelli, 3:0 w/2 abstentions).
- 4. **Annual Report Presentation** (note: this item was taken first as Mr. Quinn-Hurst had not yet arrived for item 3). Mr. Freibott presented a report on the financial status of the TIF and the forecasted 2023 revenue. Mr. Cruz made a motion to approve the report as presented (S: Ms. Richardson, Unan.).
- 3. Status Update West Central Study & REACH Mr. Quinn-Hurst of the Planning & Economic Development department introduced himself and notified the Committee that he would be managing the project going forward. Mr. Quinn-Hurst then presented a status update and summary of the Request for Qualifications under development by the City, significantly informed by recommendations made by REACH West Central. No additional action was made by the Committee at this time.
- 5. **Open Forum** No members of the public requested time to speak. Ms. Papenleur asked staff a brief question about the 6-year Capital Improvement Program, but no action was taken.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:04 PM (M: Mr. Cruz, S: Ms. Richardson, Unan.).
