




#### Two Grant Awards

1. 2014 Highway Safety Improvement Program– largest project award in the state

Project Title: Monroe Street Lane Reduction & Hardscape -

Indiana Avenue to Kiernan Avenue \$3,773,200

Scope: See enclosed Detailed Project Description

Note: Safety projects require a 10 percent local match for design and right of way; projects

that obtain construction authorization by September 30, 2017, are eligible for 100

percent federal funding for the construction phase.

- 2. 2014 WA State Bicycle & Pedestrian Safety Program
  - Awarded \$326,800 (with legislative approval)

Total Award = \$4.1 million


## Why did it receive funding?

Benefit (B) = societal cost of collisions Cost (C) = Project Cost

B/C ratio > 2 gets funded


Monroe Street B/C = 2.62

## Pedestrian Collisions




- 5 collisions in 5 years




## 3-Lane Road Volumes


