## **Improving Fire and EMS Delivery in Southwest Spokane**

Entered into supplemental response agreement with neighboring fire district
June 2014: Extended pilot Alternative Response Unit (ARU) program
January 2015: Secured \$2 million federal SAFER Grant to add 12 new firefighters
January 2015: Placed paramedics on two additional engine companies to improve EMS delivery citywide.
April 2015: Secure new fire station in southwest Spokane
Expected in May: Add fire and emergency medical service response during the day
Expected in May: Secure certificate of occupancy
Expected in September: Open station and begin 24-hour coverage
Expected in 2020: Open permanent Station 5 location
Expected in 2020: Add a third person to the Station 5 crew
