Thank you for contacting the Washington State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) and Department of Archaeology and Historic Preservation (DAHP) and providing documentation regarding the above referenced project. Please review our comments as follows:

- Should the project include the demolition of buildings that were constructed 50 or more years ago, we recommend they be recorded in our online WISAARD database on Historic Property Inventory (HPI) forms by a cultural resource professional meeting the Secretary of the Interior's Qualification Standards in Architectural History (https://www.nps.gov/history/local-law/arch_stnds_9.htm).
- We also recommend consultation with the concerned Tribes' cultural committees and staff regarding cultural resource issues.

These comments are based on the information available at the time of this review and on behalf of the SHPO in conformance with Washington State law. Should additional information become available, our assessment may be revised.
