<u>Legal Description</u>: A full legal description is available for review in the Development Services Center on the third floor of City Hall

<u>Description of Proposal</u>: This project will replace four existing fuel tanks totaling 20,000 gallons with one 30,000-gallon fuel tank. The project also will replace the existing four fuel pumps with three, new fuel pumps that will be reoriented to better accommodate traffic flow. The canopy over the gas pumps will also be replaced. The new fueling area under the canopy will be hydraulically isolated from the remaining site and drain to an oil/water separator, then to the sanitary sewer. The remainder of the disturbed site will drain to a new swale located in the northwest corner. The stormwater will then be infiltrated into ground for disposal.
