An Accessory Dwelling Unit EDR submittal must contain the following components to be considered a complete submittal. Please review the EDR Electronic File Standards for document parameters and naming conventions.

Requirement PLANS	Plan submittal shall include a minimum of: • Floor Plan • Footings/foundation • Elevations • Cross section • Detail of wall/ceiling rated separation between ADU and Dwelling Unit (1-Hour) or Garage (Separation per IRC 302.6) • One-Hour Exterior Fire Rated Wall Detail or listed assembly • Where exterior wall of detached ADU is less than 5' to property line (with Planning Approval). • Must Follow EDR Electronic File Standards Accessory Dwelling Unit Overview Contact Planning Department for questions on allowable ADU square footage (509)-625-6188

Application Submittal	Application information shall be submitted along with the required submittal documents via Accela Citizen Access. All documents must be in compliance with EDR Electronic File Standards.
