There are five (5) classes of license; their fees and minimum requirements are:

1st Class Boiler Operator (1stC)

Two (2) years of practical experience as a boiler operator with eighteen (18) months of that experience in a high pressure plant; or, certification from a recognized school of technology devoted to steam engineering and one (1) year of practical experience as a boiler operator. This license authorizes the holder to operate any and all boilers.

2nd Class Boiler Operator (2ndC)

One (1) year of practical experience as a boiler operator in a high-pressure plant. The license authorizes the holder to operate a steam plant not exceeding 8,000,000 BTU input or to act and operate as assistant operator to a 1st Class Boiler Operator.

3rd Class Boiler Operator (3rdC)

One (1) year of practical experience as a boiler operator. This license authorizes the holder to operate a steam plant not exceeding 4,000,000 BTU input or to have charge of an opposite shift to a 2nd Class Boiler Operator.

Small High-Pressure Boiler Operator (SHPB)

No experience required; applicant must be 18 years old. This license authorizes the holder to operate a small high-pressure boiler not to exceed 800,000 BTU input or 150 PSI.

Low-Pressure Boiler Operation (LPB)

No experience required; applicant must be 18 years old. This license authorizes the holder to operate any low -pressure boiler not to exceed 15 lbs (steam) or not to exceed 160 PSI and/or 250 degrees Fahrenheit (water).

Applying for Your License

To take the exam, please submit this completed application and \$110 exam fee to the Development Services Center by the Monday before the exam date. Applying for exams can also be accomplished through our online permit by creating an account, *which will be required for renewing your license*, though our online permit system. (aca.spokanepermits.org)

Once you apply, you'll have **three months to take the exam**. If the exam has not been taken within that time, a new application and exam fee will be required. Exams are scored immediately, and upon request, your permanent license can be printed and mailed to you.

For failed examinations, 60 days must pass before re-applying and paying a new exam fee to retake the test.

License Expiration & Renewal

All licenses **expire on December 31st** each year. For those that pass their license examination after September 30th, their first license will be valid for both the current year and the following year. If you pass the exam on or before September 30th, your license will be valid through the remainder of the current year.

To ensure a smooth **renewal process**, please keep your contact information up to date through your online, City of Spokane Permit & Licensing, account. Each November, a renewal notification will be sent to your registered email as your reminder for the need to pay the annual licensing fee by December 31st to keep your license active for another year.
