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Introduction

The Longitudinal Systems Analysis (LSA) compiles the data within the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) of those who were served in Emergency Shelter, Transitional Housing, Rapid Rehousing, Permanent Supportive Housing (disability required for entry), Permanent Housing with Services, and Permanent Housing projects within the Continuum of Care during the year. It contains information on demographics, patterns of system usage, length of time homeless, the needs of specific populations, and exit destinations. Please note any data entered in a comparable database is not included in this report. Aggregate data provided in the LSA is combined with the Housing Inventory Count (HIC) and Point-in-Time (PIT) count to help create an annual report to U.S. Congress from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) on homelessness called the Annual Homeless Assessment Report (AHAR). The information contained below is based on the 2024 LSA Reporting Year, which runs from October 1st, 2023, to September 30th, 2024. It is based on all households and population types. The HMIS team works for several months with the support of providers to submit the LSA every year the January following the end of the reporting period. It takes several iterations before the data is accepted and eventually considered final. In the 2024 Reporting Year, the LSA was submitted on time and considered final within a week of the due date.

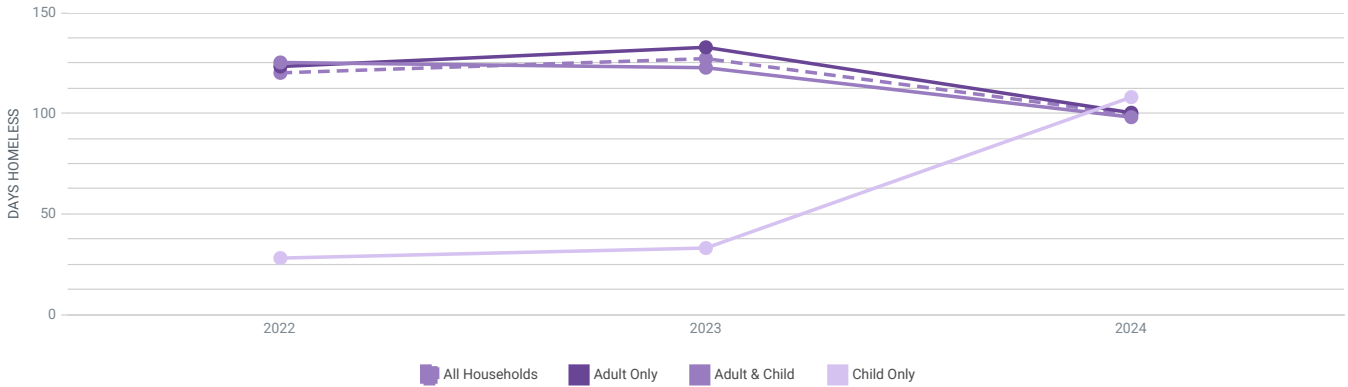

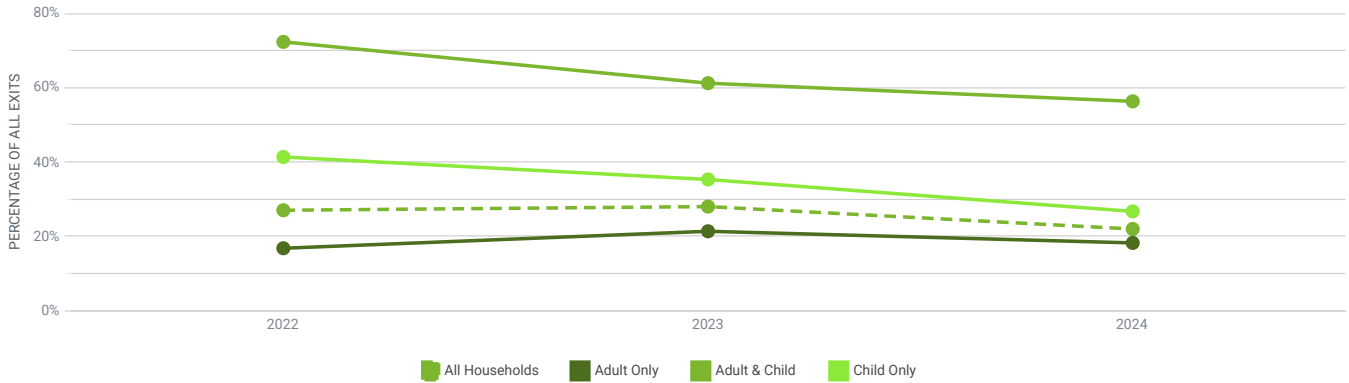
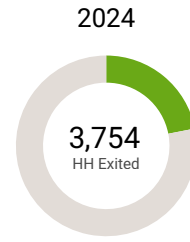
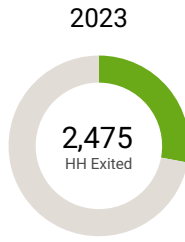
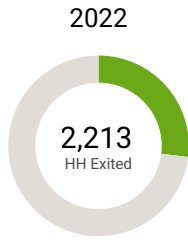
Days Homeless Trend by Household Type

For each reporting year, the average cumulative, unduplicated number of days that households were served in ES, SH, or TH projects; and days in RRH:H or PSH prior to move-in.



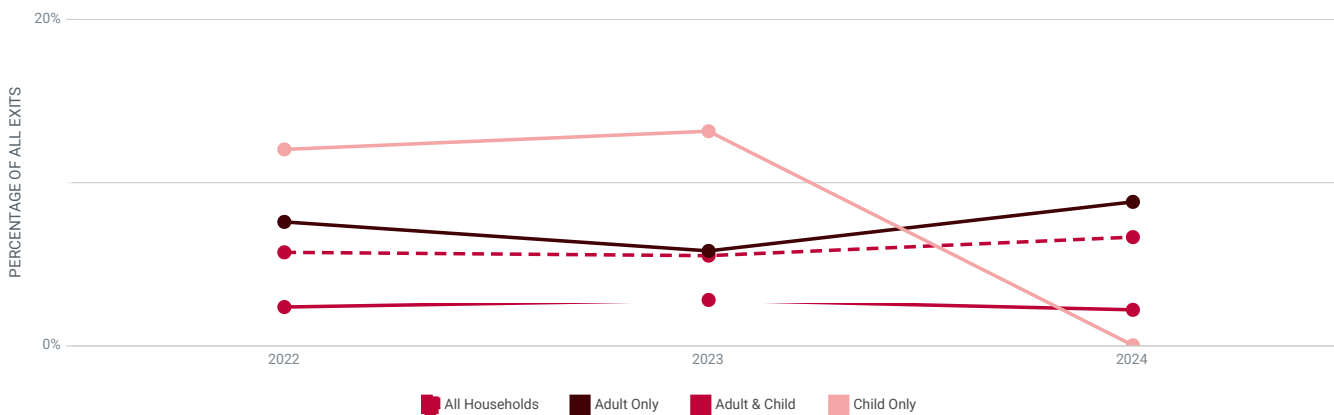
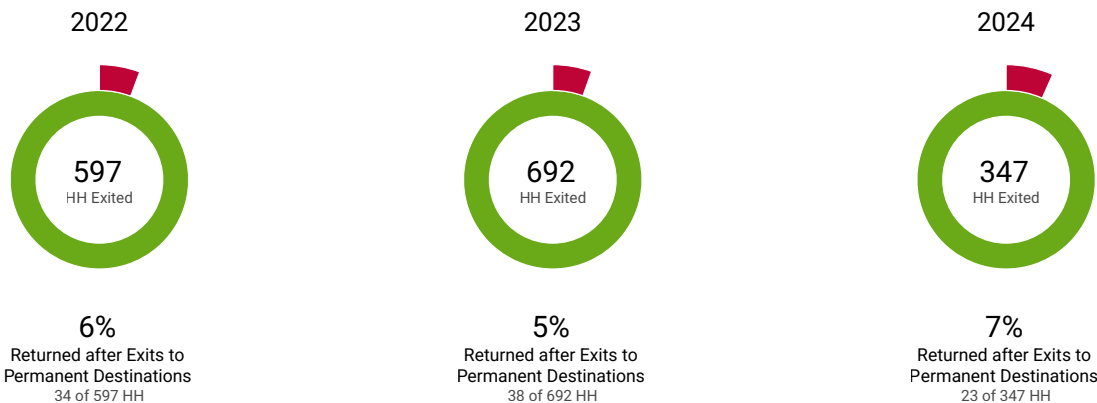
Exits to Permanent Destinations Trend

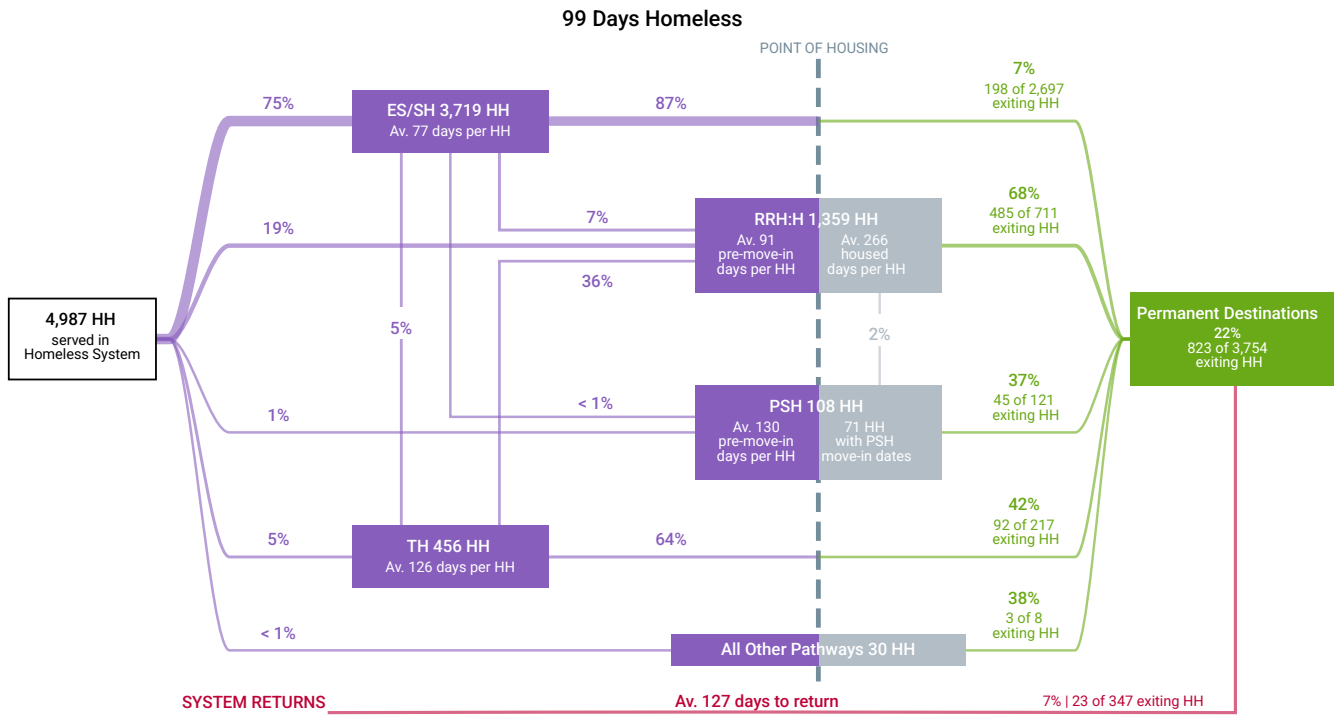

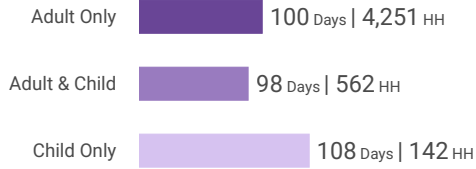

Time Distribution of Days Homeless

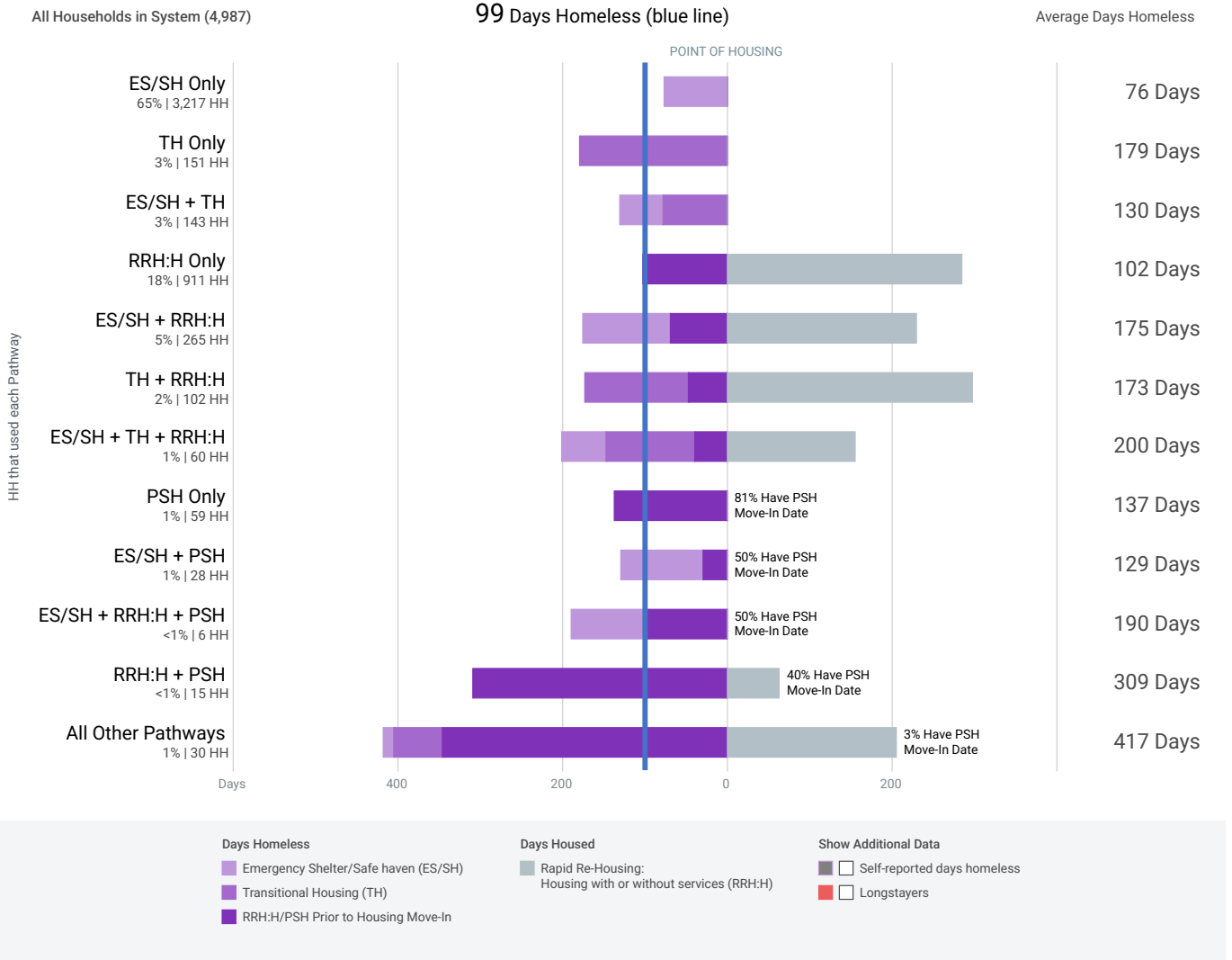

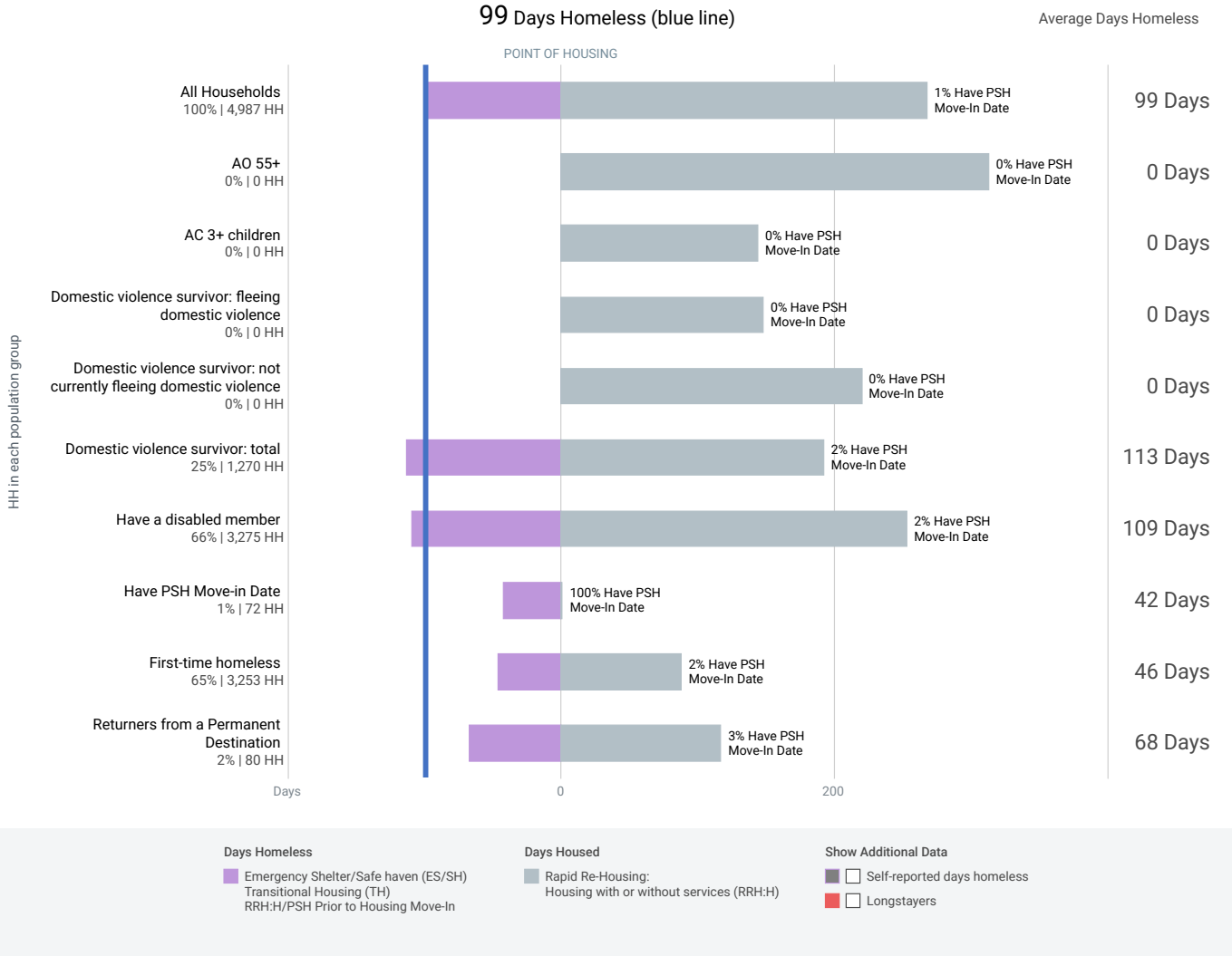

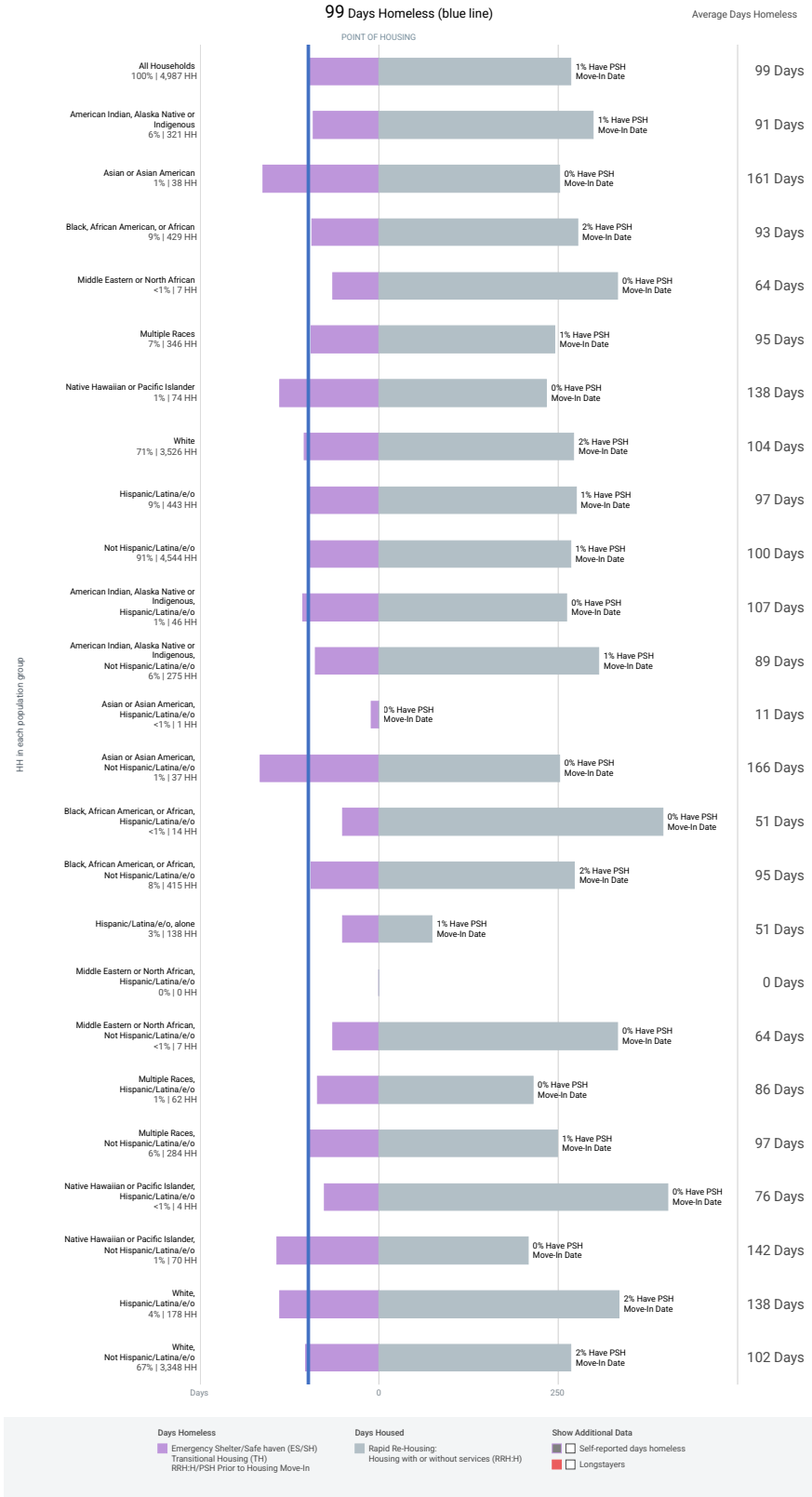

Percent of households that exited to permanent, temporary, and unknown destinations by household type.

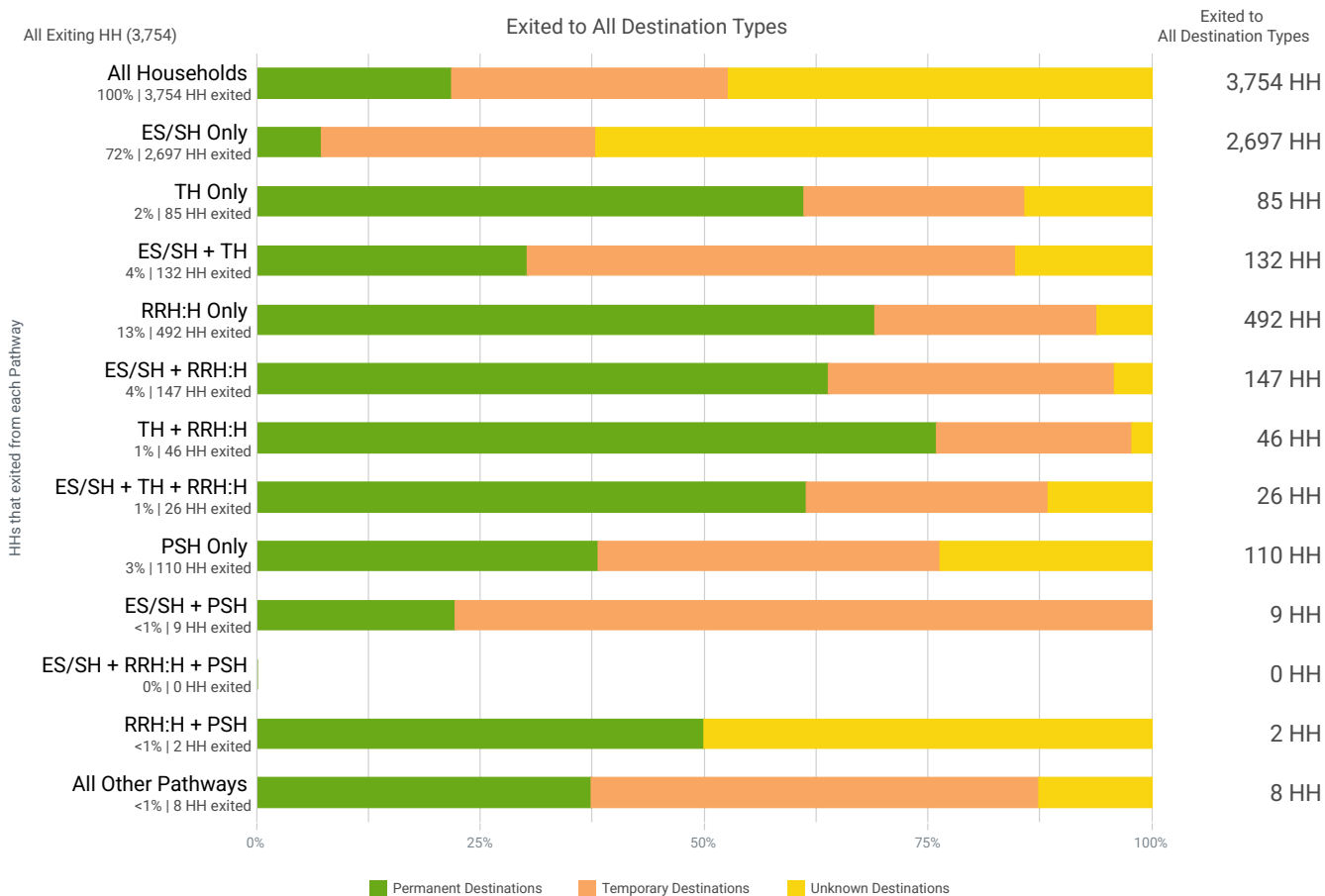

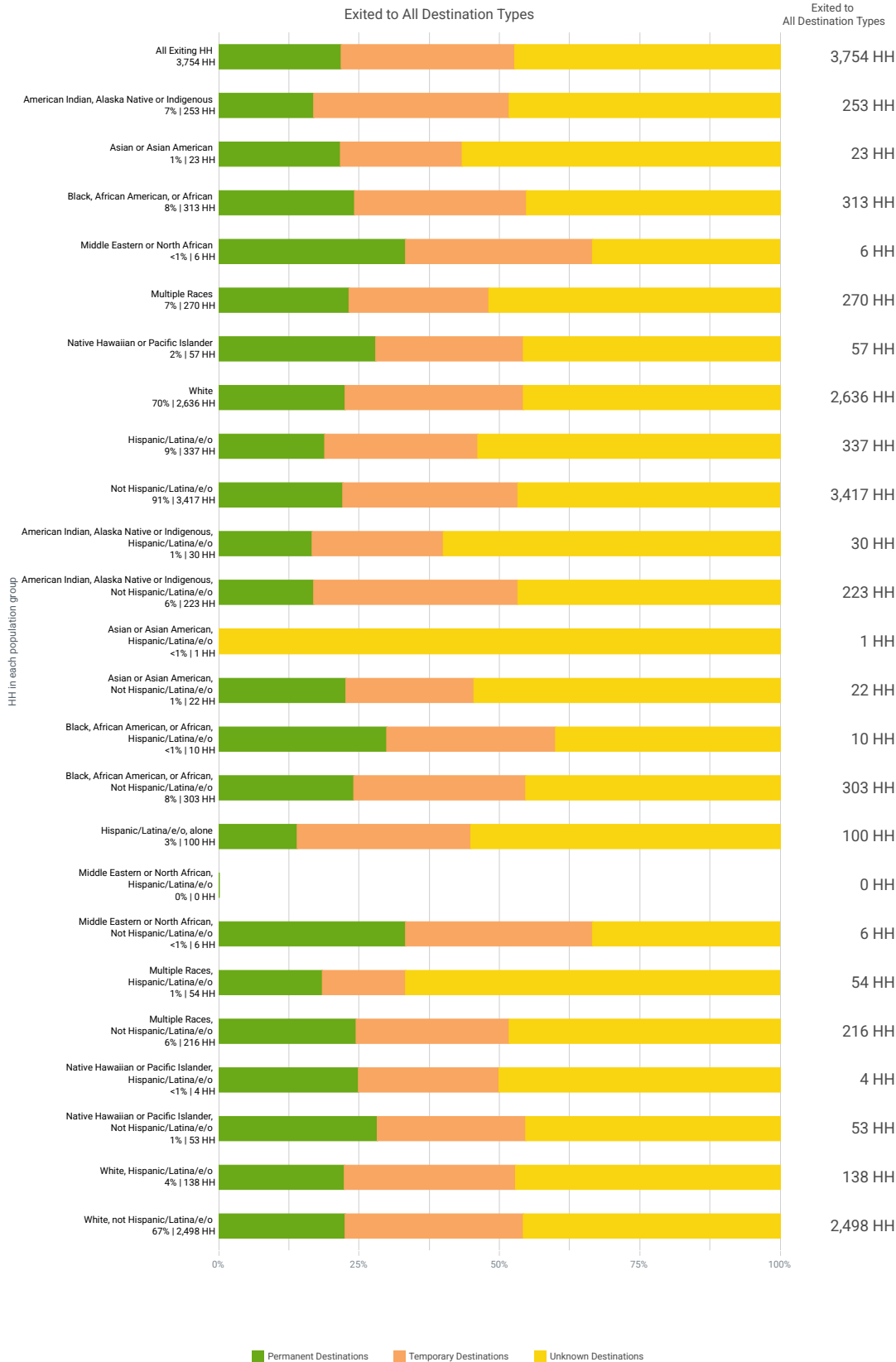

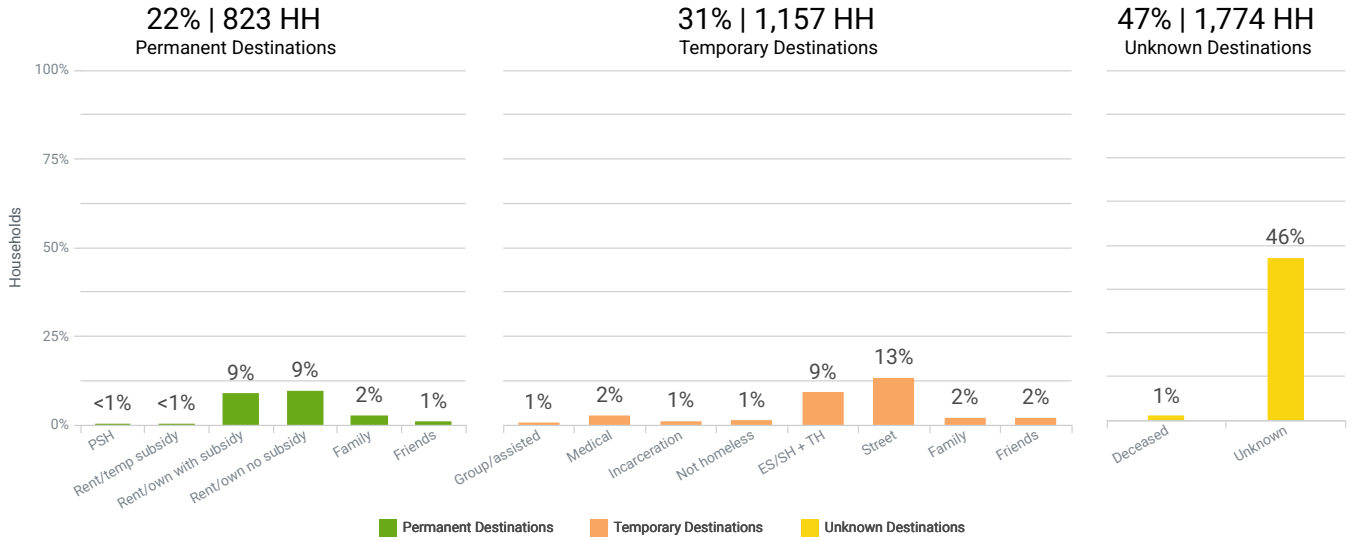

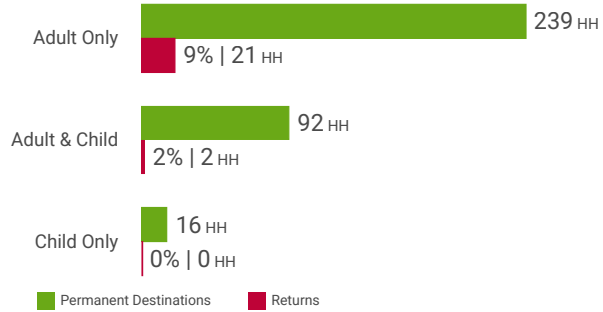

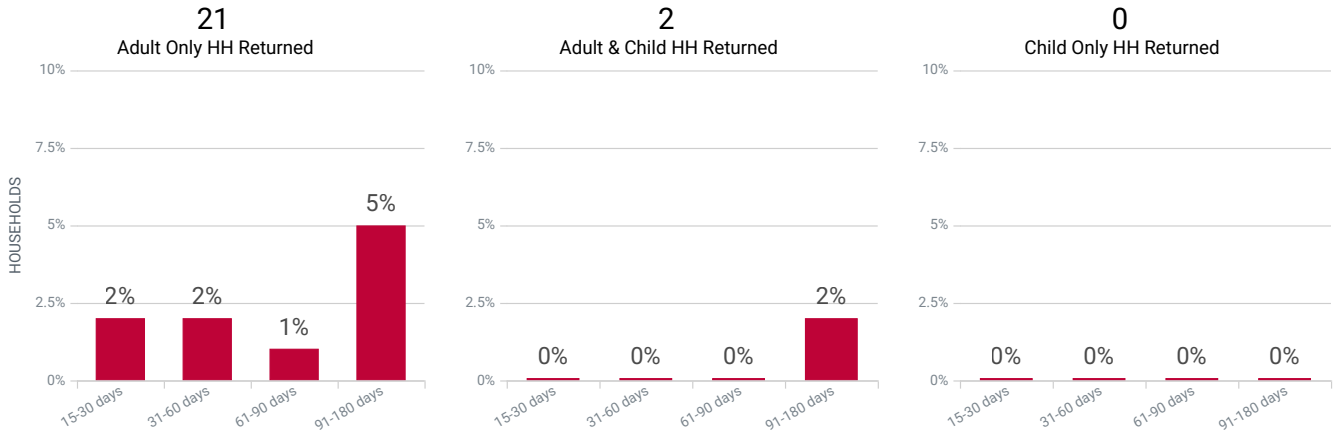

Time Distribution of Returns

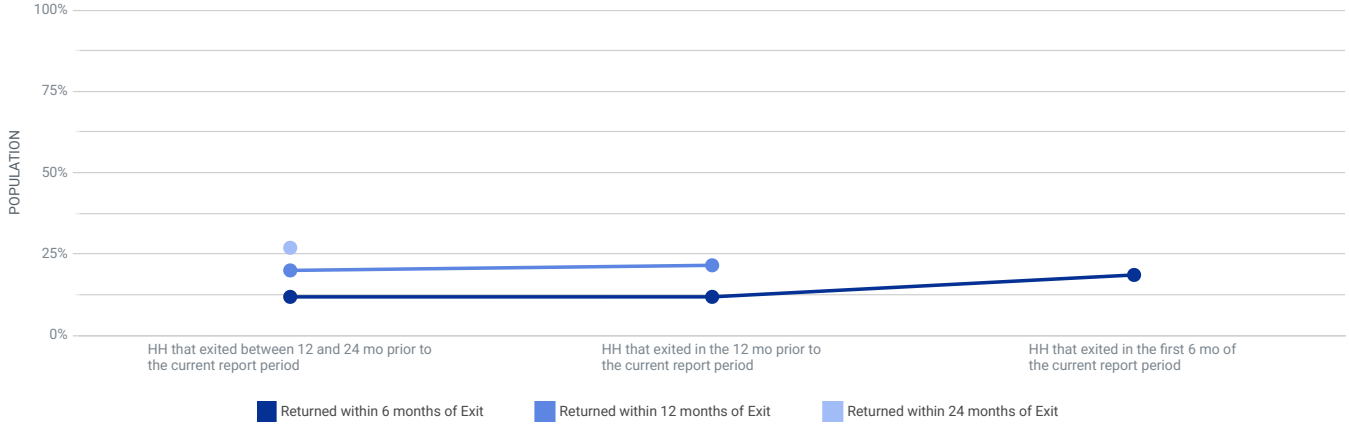

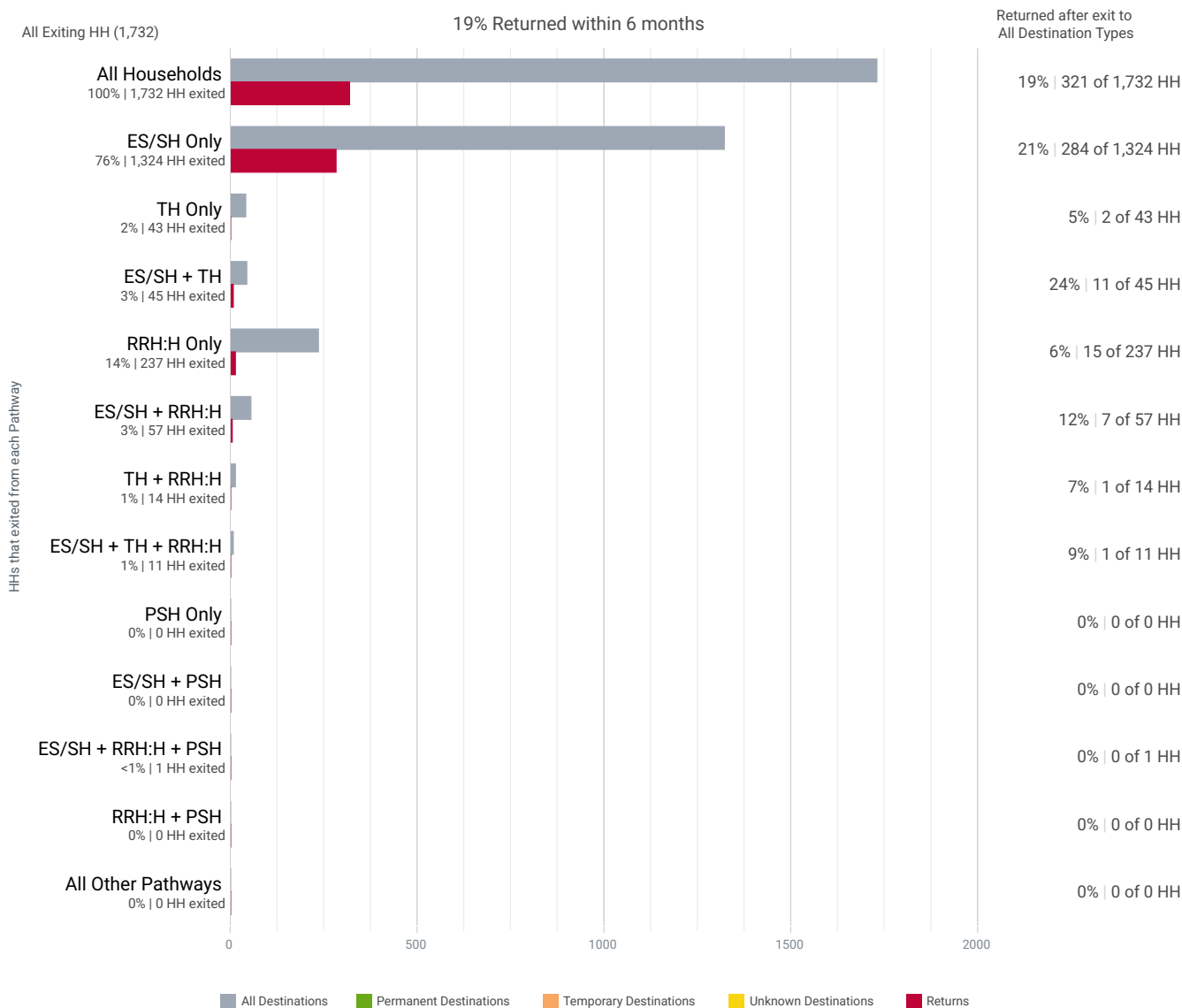

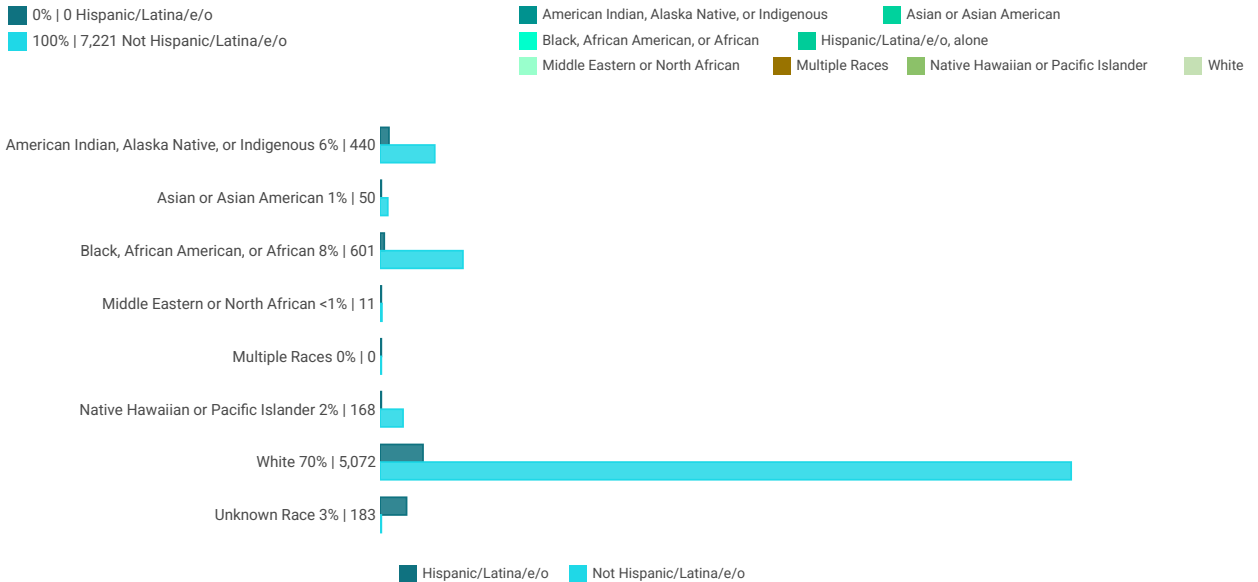

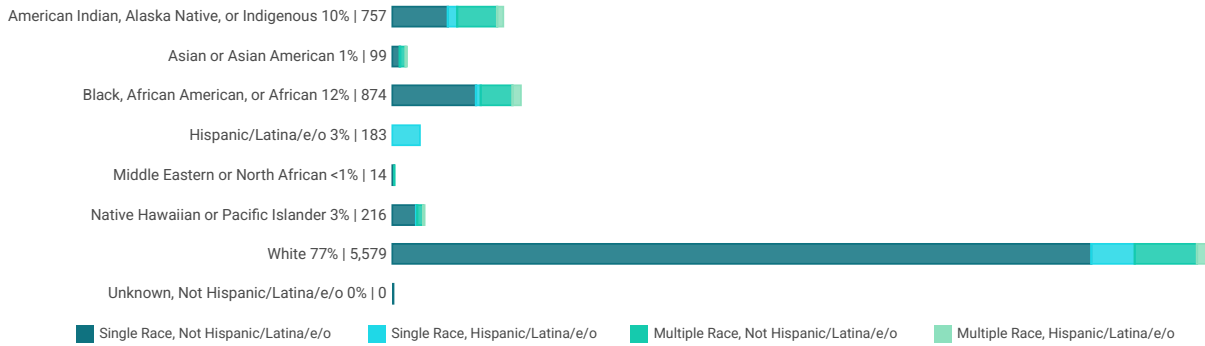

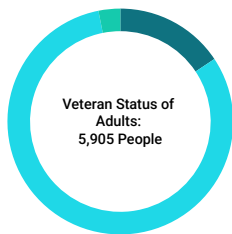

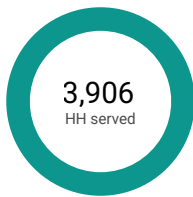

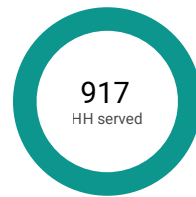

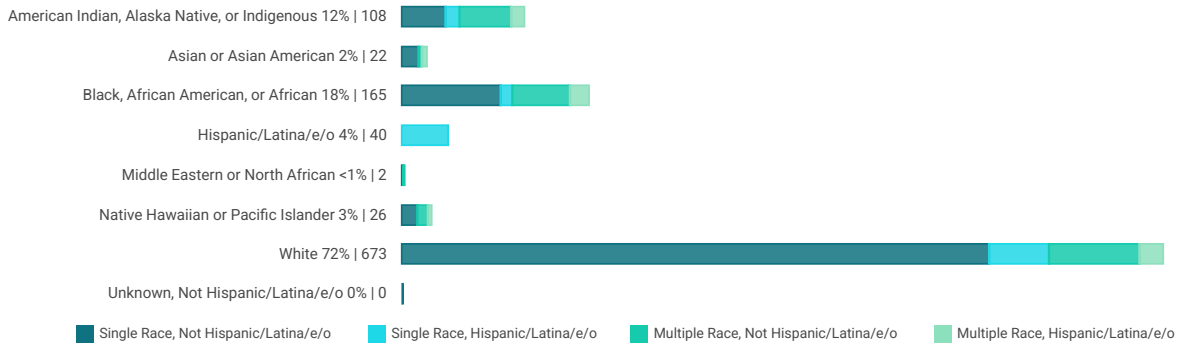

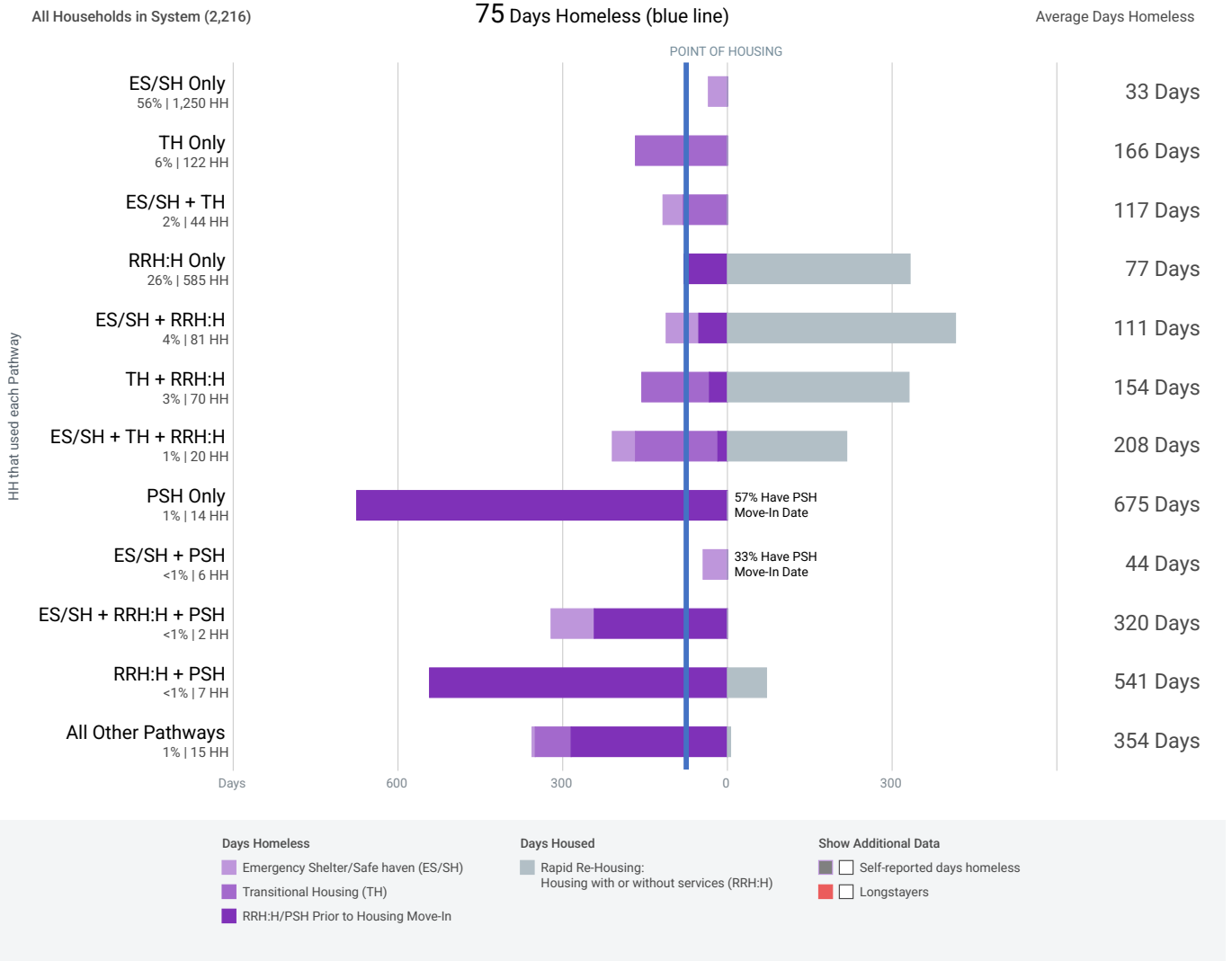

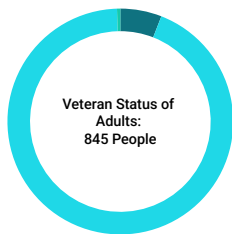
