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Introduction

The Longitudinal System Analysis (LSA) is an annual report submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) that provides a comprehensive view of how individuals experiencing homelessness interact with services over time. Drawing on data from the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS), the LSA examines patterns such as system entries and exits, length of time homeless, returns to homelessness, demographics, and service utilization. This analysis helps evaluate the overall effectiveness of the Spokane Regional Continuum of Care (CoC) in addressing homelessness.

The information presented below reflects the 2025 LSA reporting year, which spans October 1, 2024, through September 30, 2025. Each year, the HMIS team collaborates with service providers to prepare and submit the LSA in January following the reporting period. The process involves multiple iterations to ensure accuracy before HUD accepts the data as final, including addressing “flags” assigned by HUD for data quality. For the 2025 reporting year, the LSA was submitted on time.

Data in this report includes households served in HMIS-participating projects during the reporting period across the following project types:

- Emergency Shelter (ES): Short-term crisis intervention providing immediate shelter.
- Transitional Housing (TH): One- to two-year program offering intensive case management to stabilize households and prepare them for independent living.
- Rapid Rehousing (RRH): Short- to medium-term rental assistance paired with case management, with households securing housing in the open market.
- Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH): Permanent subsidy with case management for individuals with disabilities; units are pre-identified.

Please note: Data from Victim Service Provider organizations is excluded from this report.

LSA aggregate data is combined with the Housing Inventory Count (HIC) and Point-in-Time (PIT) count to inform HUD’s Annual Homeless Assessment Report (AHAR) to Congress. Performance data is reported for all specific household and population types, including:

- All Households: Includes every household type and those with incomplete data.
- Adult Only (AO): Households where all members are 18 or older. Subcategories include:
 - AO Veteran: At least one member served in the U.S. Armed Forces.

- AO Non-veteran 25+: All members are 25 or older, none have served in the military.
- AO 18–24: All members are between 18 and 24 years old.
- AO 55+: All members are at least 55 years old.
- Adult & Child (AC): Households with at least one adult and one child.
 - Subcategory:
 - AC Parenting Youth: All adults are between 18 and 24, and at least one adult is the parent of a child.
 - AC 3+ Children: At least one adult and three or more children.
- Child Only (CO): Households where all members are 17 or younger.
- All Child and Youth: Includes households where all members are under 25, encompassing CO, AO 18–24, and AC Parenting Youth households.
- Long-Term: Households with 365 or more cumulative days experiencing homelessness; any household type can be included.
- Inflow: Households with less than 365 cumulative days experiencing homelessness; any household type can be included.
- Have a Disabled Member: Households where the head of household or an adult reported a disabling condition during the reporting period.
- First-Time: Households entering ES, SH, TH, RRH, or PSH during the report period with no prior enrollment in the past two years.
- Returning: Households entering ES, SH, TH, RRH, or PSH during the report period with a previous exit to permanent housing within 15–730 days prior to enrollment.

2025 LSA Overview

The 2025 Longitudinal System Analysis (LSA) highlights significant progress across key performance measures, including higher rates of exits to permanent housing and fewer returns to homelessness. These improvements reflect the impact of targeted strategies, such as scattered-site Emergency Shelters, and strong collaboration among partners to enhance housing outcomes. Additionally, a likely contributor to the decline in new entries into the homeless system is the expansion of homeless and eviction prevention funding, which helps stabilize individuals before they require formal homeless services.

Data quality also saw substantial improvement, with a 67.5% increase from 2023 LSA data based on HUD Flags for data validation, ensuring greater accuracy and reliability in reporting to support informed decision-making. In 2023, the LSA cleanup began with 160 flags and concluded with 55 remaining. For the 2025 LSA, the process started with 52 flags and was reduced to 26 at final upload, demonstrating continued progress in data integrity.






Days Homeless Trend by Household Type









Time Distribution of Days Homeless











Exits by Destination Type















Time Distribution of Returns






















































































































