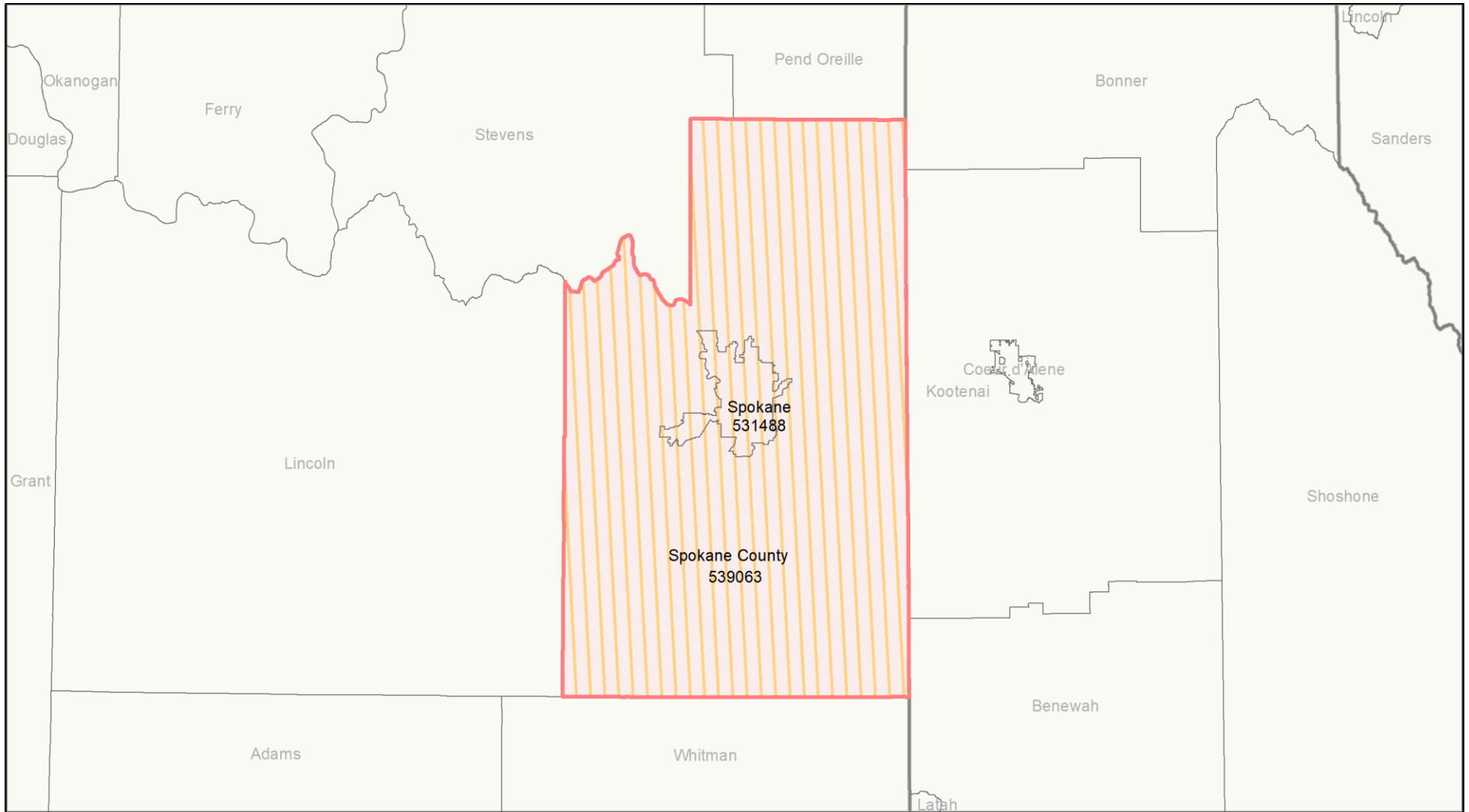

 2020 CoC Boundary  2019 CoC Boundary



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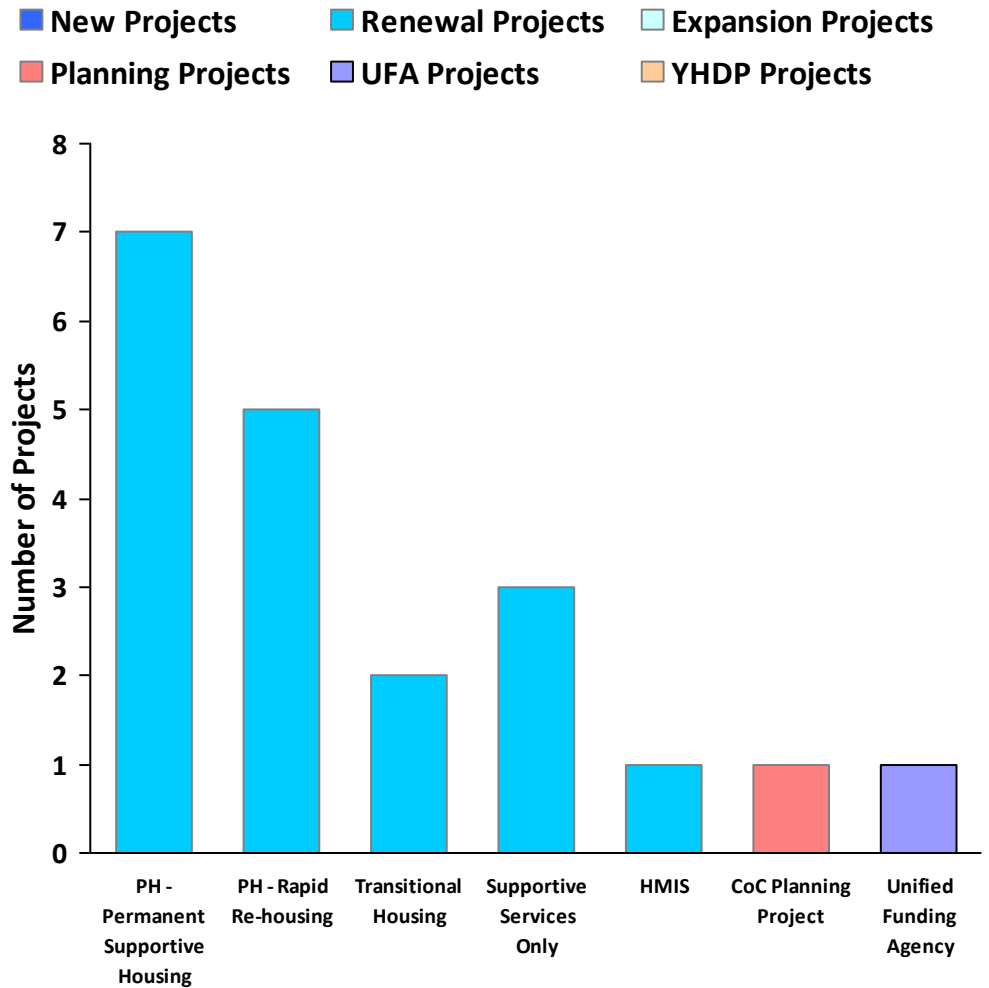
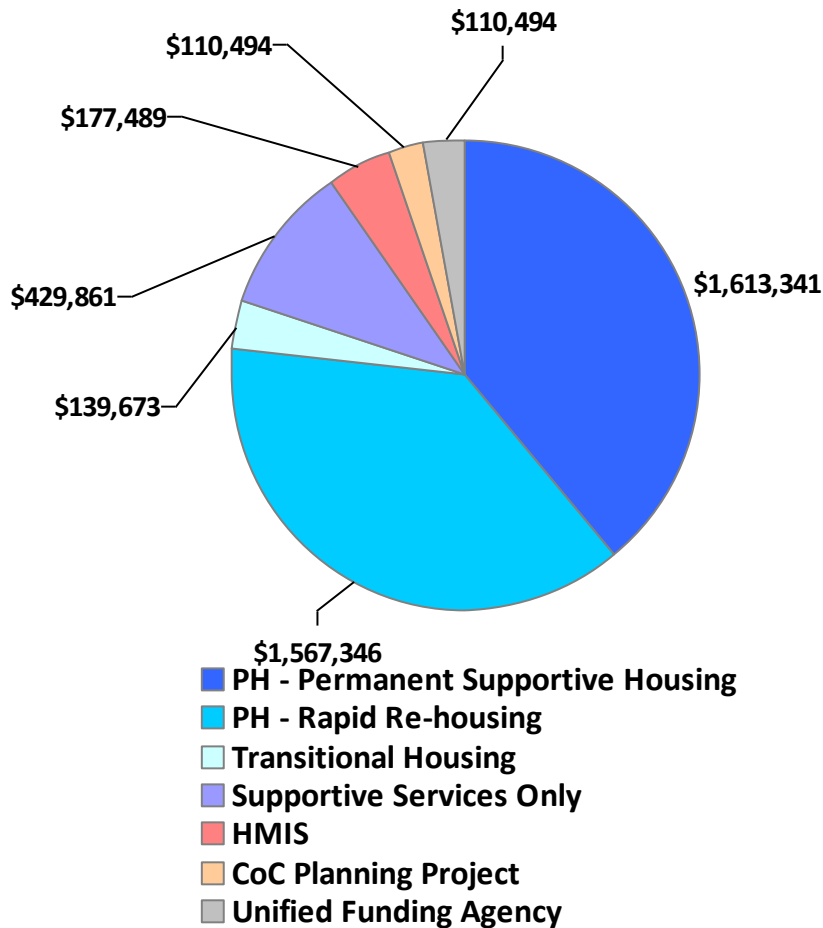

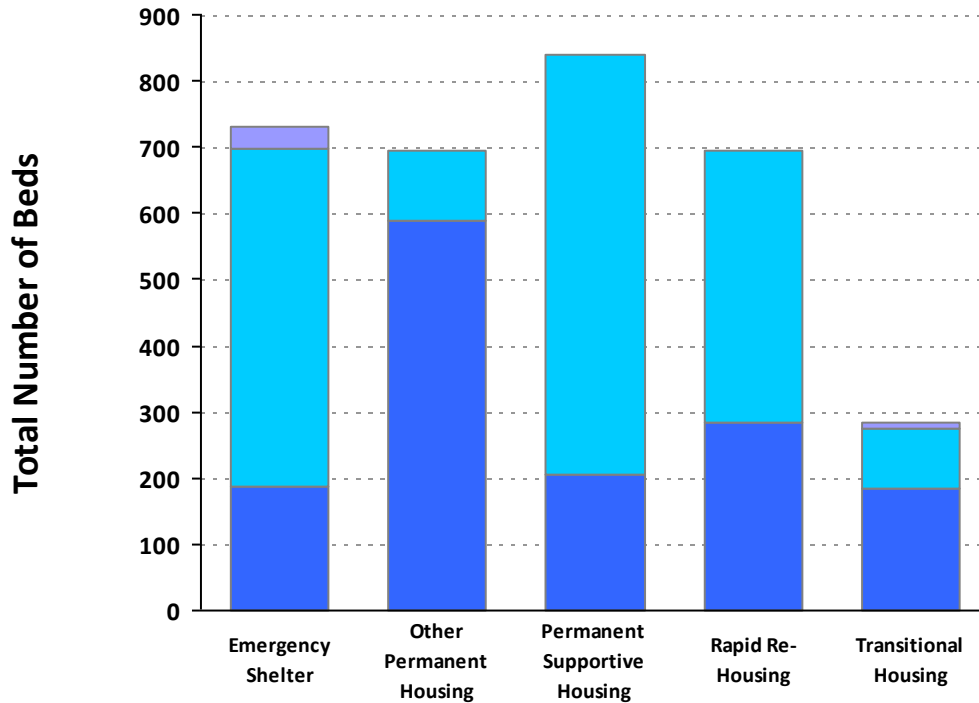
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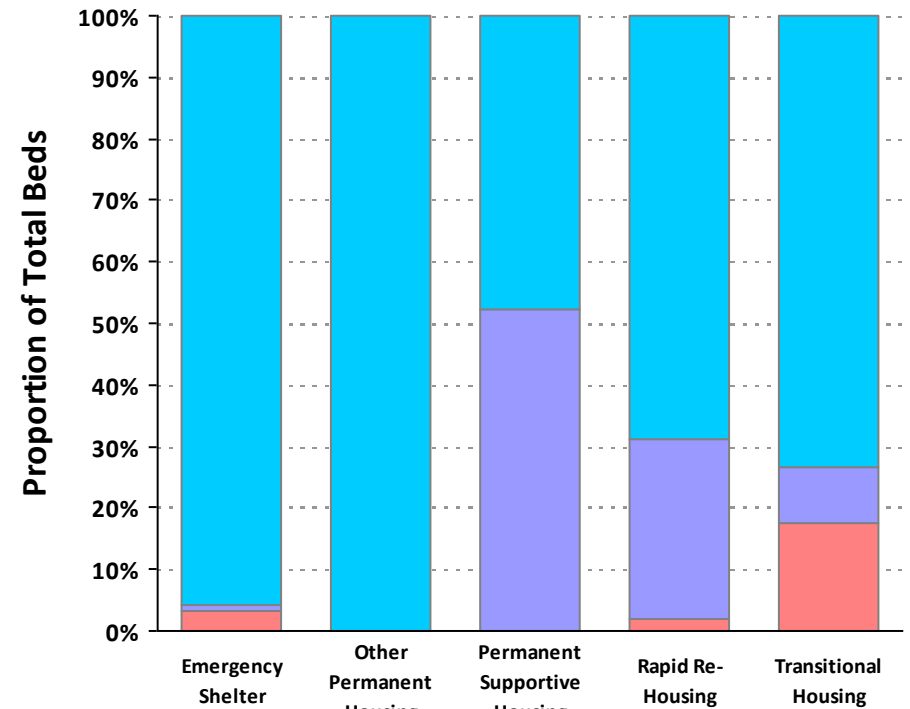

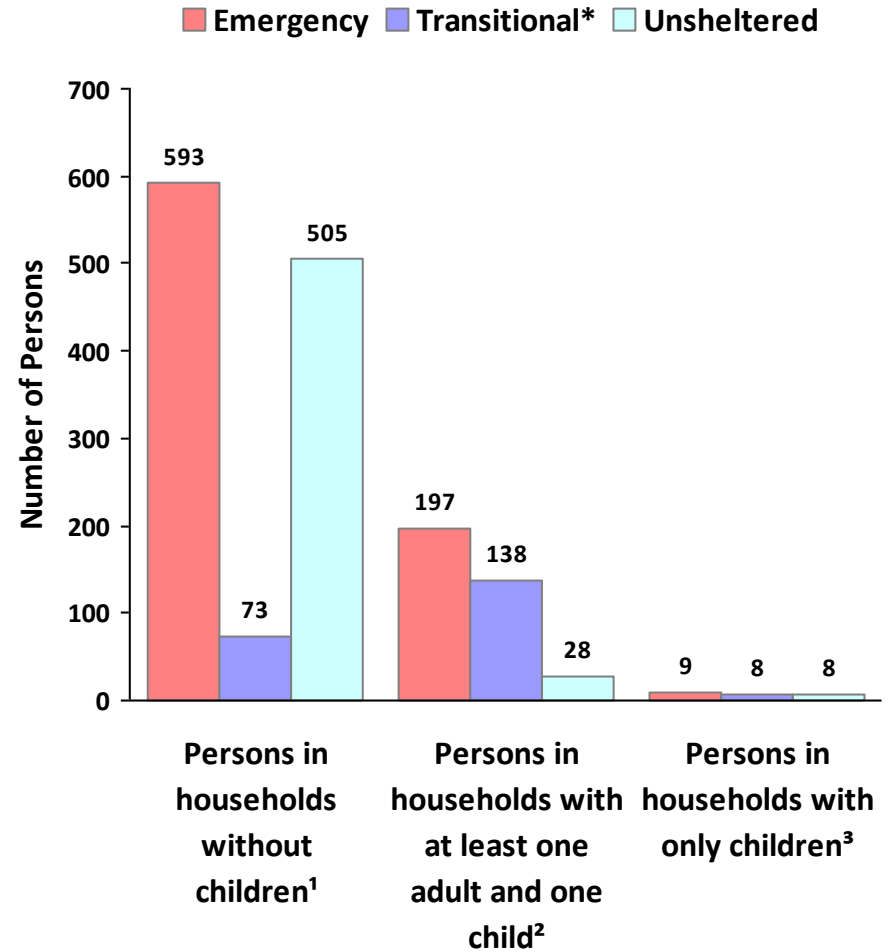
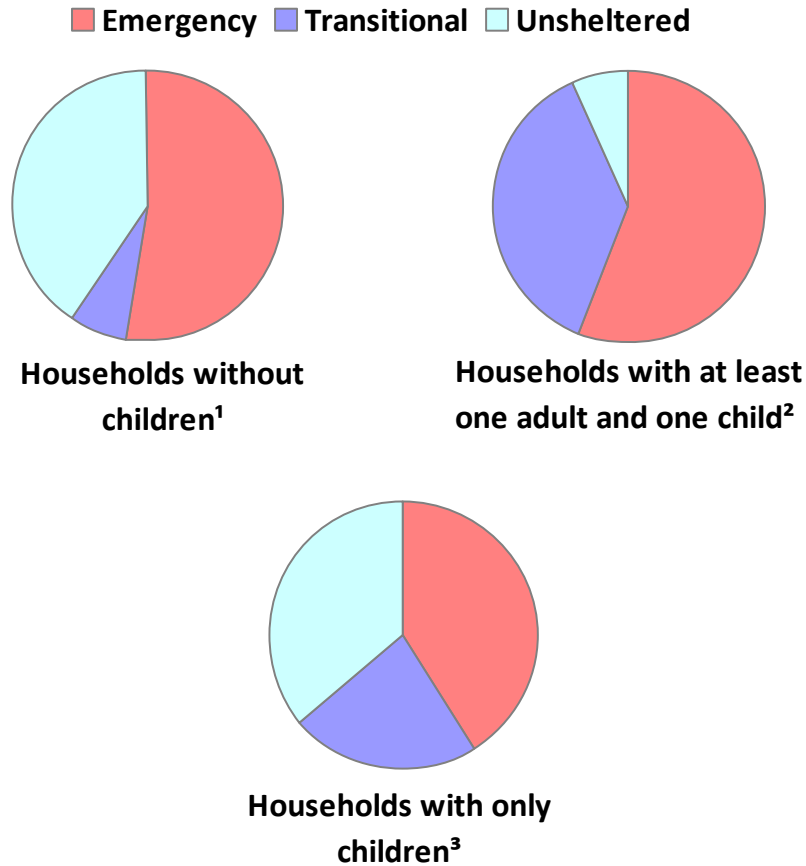

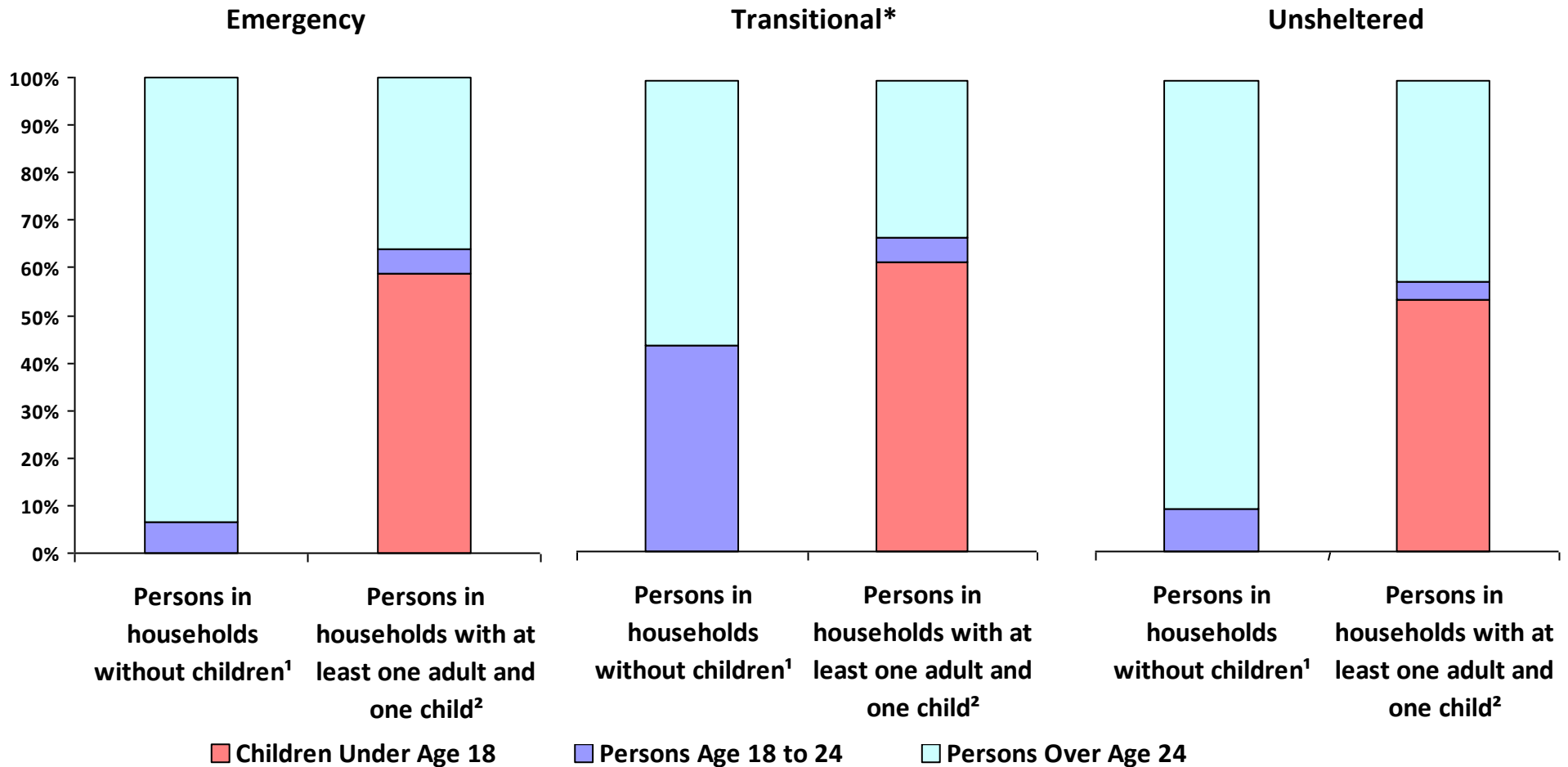

2020 Point-In-Time Count Proportion of Persons in each Age Group by Household Type



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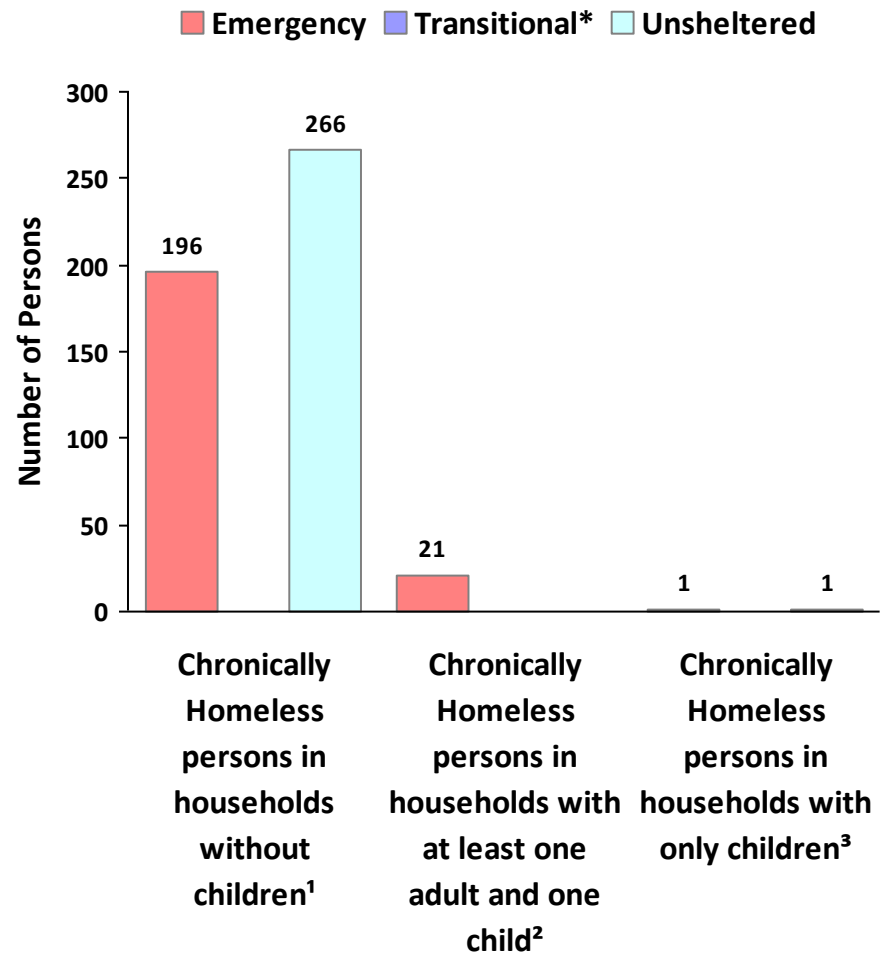
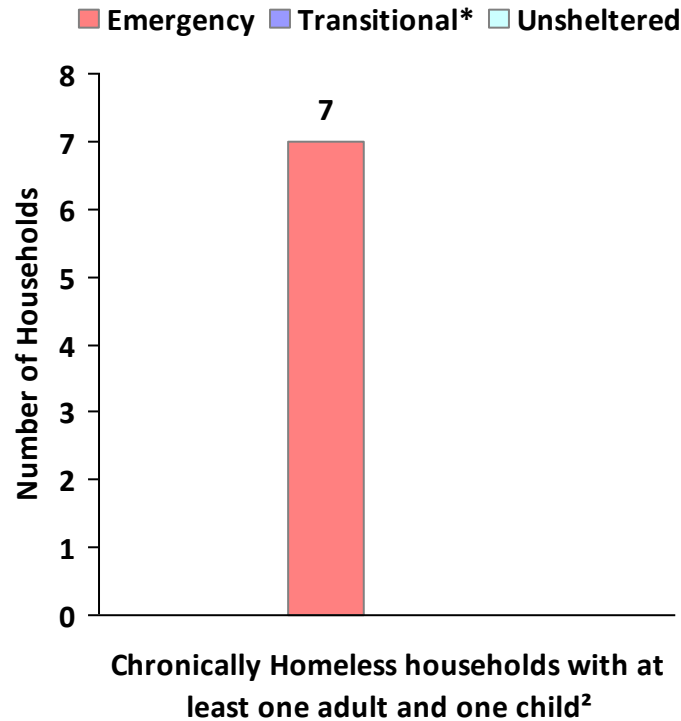
