

Inclement Weather Overview

CHHS is required to activate surge capacity in alignment with Spokane Municipal Code (SMC).

- Per SMC 02.04.045 inclement weather services are activated during the following weather events:
 - Days during which the wind chill is forecasted by the National Weather Service (Spokane - GEG) to be thirty-two (32) degrees Fahrenheit or lower.
 - Days during which the **heat index** is predicted by the National Weather Service (Spokane - GEG) to be 95 (ninety-five) degrees Fahrenheit or higher for two (2) consecutive days or more.
 - It is important to note that during the heat index activations overnight shelter beds are only activated if the overnight heat index is predicted to remain above 95 degrees, otherwise daytime space(s) will be the focus of heat index activation.
 - Any day when the Spokane Regional Clean Air Agency forecasts the current air quality index to reach 201 or higher.
