



Consolidated Homeless Grant (CHG) Training Requirements

CHG training requirements apply to staff who provide direct services, supervisors of direct service staff, and staff that manage homeless grants. Training must be completed at least once every three years, and attendance must be documented. Refer to the sample [CHG Staff Training Record](#) for an example of how to document training attendance.
