The City of Spokane's Community, Housing, and Human Services Department (CHHS) will hold a Public Hearing to provide information and invite public comment regarding the City's intent to allocate \$100,000 from the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) in response to COVID-19's impact on small businesses. The goal of this project is to retain and/or create jobs for low and moderate income individuals.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions on groups larger than 10 and social distancing, CHHS will host this meeting online using the Webex application. Interested individuals are encouraged to join the meeting. Please note that no public comment will be taken during the meeting. CHHS will allow 30 days for citizens to review the recorded public hearing and associated resources.
