



A tax credit for Washington workers!

The Working Families Tax Credit will provide payments up to \$1,255 to individuals and families who meet the requirements.

What is this refund?

- A tax credit for **low-to-moderate income** individuals and families.
- Provides payments up to \$1,255 to **individuals** and **families** who meet the eligibility requirements.
- Payments are based on income level and the number of qualifying children.
- Applications opened on February 1, 2024, for tax year 2023 .
- Applications can be submitted for up to three years from the date the federal tax return was due.

Who is eligible for the tax credit?

Number of qualifying children	Applicant must make less than the following		Maximum refund
	Single	Married (filing jointly)	
0	\$17,640	\$24,210	\$315
1	\$46,560	\$53,120	\$625
2	\$52,918	\$59,478	\$940
3 <i>or more</i>	\$56,838	\$63,398	\$1,255

Applicants must have:

- Filed a federal income tax return.
- A valid Social Security Number (SSN) or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN).
- Met requirements for the federal EITC **OR** would have met the requirements for EITC but filed with an ITIN.
- Lived in Washington State for more than 183 days the previous year.
- Be at least 25 years old and less than 65 **OR** had a qualifying child.

What you'll need to apply

- Copy of your federal tax return
- SSN or ITIN
- Dates of birth for you, spouse, and children (if applicable)
- Washington state driver's license number or photo ID
- Current mailing address
- Bank account number & routing number, if you chose direct deposit
- Applicant(s) signatures.

Why should people apply?

- Direct, flexible cash to meet essential needs.
- Pay for rent, groceries, down payment for a car, etc.
- Put into savings
- College tuition
- Any expense! You can use this extra cash for any purpose

The latest data available from the Department of Revenue states in Spokane County 15,136 applications were received and 12,326 were refunded for a credit of \$9,364,036 into our community with many application still pending. There are an estimated 29,541 eligible which accounts for 8% of the state total. Roughly 17,215 have not applied for the refund in Spokane County and are estimated to be eligible for the refund.
