Dear Mayor Condon:

Thank you for your request to amend your Community Empowerment Zone boundaries. I am pleased to inform you the Department of Commerce has approved your request in accordance with 43.31C.050 RCW pursuant to the application received June 3, 2019 and subsequent information received August 1, 2019.

As you know, the CEZ designation enables economically disadvantaged urban areas to qualify for special tax incentives intended to support reinvestment in the zone. Reinvestment is expected to create business and job growth. Qualified businesses located in the zone, or that hire residents of the zone, may apply to the Department of Revenue for sales tax deferrals and business and occupation tax credits.

The amended Community Empowerment Zone boundaries are as set forth on the attached map.
